

CORPUS CHRISTI HOME & SCHOOL BOARD MEETING

- I. **Opening Prayer was led by Mrs. Lafferty**
- II. **Principal's Update – Mrs. Lafferty**
 - A. Enrollment for 2021-2022: 407 students enrolled for next school year.
 - a. There will be 2 Kindergarten classes for next year, therefore another Kindergarten teacher will be hired.
 - b. New teachers being hired for 7a and 7b.
 - B. **End of Year Activities:** Corpus will have some end of year activities.
 - a. **May Procession –** Held Monday May 24th.
 - b. **8th Grade Graduation-** There will be Graduation in the Church and video afterwards presented in the gym.
 - c. **Kindergarten Graduation –** Will be held in the Gym.
 - d. **Pre-School Graduation –** Will be held outside.
 - e. **Last Day of School:** Prayer service is being planned with end of year Awards. To be announced.
 - C. **Educational notes for 2021-2022:** Corpus will be using a new Math and Religion Series (except for Honors Math upper grades). Honors ELA will have a new ELA series. New Social Studies series in 7th and 8th grades.
 - a. **Pebble Go Extra:** Home and School will be paying for the Pebble Go Extra Series to benefit Library. This is a \$200 Fee.
 - D. **Masks:** Corpus continuing to follow guidance of Archdiocese on masks. Must wear until end of school year as of posting of these Meeting Minutes.
 - E. **Safety:** The Safety Panic Button System in the office will be changing in late 2021. School will need to connect to the new system which will be \$5000 for the first year and \$600 for each year after. This Panic Button connects to local police, fire, 911 in event of an emergency. Home and School will be paying for this out of the H&S Funds.
 - F. **Lunch Monitors 2021-2022:** There are budget restrictions which will mean Corpus will need to continue with assistance of parents as Lunch Monitors for 2021-2022.
 - G. **August Envelope:** The August Envelopes will return this year and be distributed the weekends of August 21-22 and August 28-29. More information and Volunteer sign up (to assist with putting together the August envelopes) to come this summer.
 - H. **EXAMS:** End of year assessments will begin May 25th.
