

# CORPUS CHRISTI HOME & SCHOOL BOARD MEETING

**II. Principal's Update – Mrs. Lafferty**

- A. **Virtual School** – Per Montgomery County Board of Health, school will transition to virtual learning effective Monday November 23, 2020 thru Friday December 4, 2020. Monday December 7<sup>th</sup> will be a virtual school day for Corpus also. There is no school on Tuesday, December 8<sup>th</sup>. Students will return to school on Wednesday December 9 for in person lessons. Virtual school schedule for each day for each grade was distributed to all parents via Option C on Thursday 11/19/2020. All families need to return the request for virtual instruction to school in order to be counted for attendance.
- B. **Report Cards:** Report Cards will be issued on Friday December 4 via Option C.
- C. **COVID:** Students are doing well with the social distancing and masks. If returning to school in December, students will need to wear masks during gym and recess time also due to updated mask mandates.
- D. **Terra Nova Testing:** Testing is scheduled to occur in March 2021.
- E. **Second Grade Sacraments:** Sacraments will be decided depending on COVID restrictions in Spring 2021.
- F. **Beacon Testing:** Corpus completed Beacon testing last school year and it was a trial period for one year. Corpus signed up to complete Beacon testing again however COVID has impacted that.

- A. **Pending Auction Items:** Katie Adinolfi and Angie Lafond have organized all pending Auction items from 2019-2020 and have arranged all outstanding auction items.
- G. **TREASURER UPDATE:**
  - a. Popsicles - \$3000 received for this fundraiser.
  - b. Hot Dog Day - \$7000 received for this fundraiser.
  - c. Chick Fil A Days – This is still being collected and calculated.
  - d. Depending on virtual instruction, Popsicle days, Hot Dog Days and Chick Fil A Days may be rescheduled to a different month.
- H. **Lunch Monitor Update:** Parents are volunteering and Lunch Monitor sign up genius going well. Mrs. Greenberg collecting data on parents that are volunteering and Helen Chappell assisting with the list of parent volunteers that will go into the tuition drawing at end of 2021.
- I. **Dr. Katherine Dahlsgaard, CHOP, Pediatric Psychologist:** Dr. Dahlsgaard will be presenting a free Zoom lecture on Tuesday December 1, 2020 to all Corpus parents. Theme is "Positive Psychology for the Holidays" geared towards COVID, the holidays and anxiety in children.
