

School Café Point of Sale System

Corpus Christi School Nutrition Services (North Penn SD) uses an electronic point of service (POS) system in the Corpus Christi school cafeteria. The name of the system is School Café. The POS system requires each student to input an individual secure ID number, obtained directly from the school.

School Café allows parents to:

- 1. View your student's cafeteria account balance and purchases.
- 2. Receive low balance e-mail messages.
- 3. Monitor what your student has been purchasing.
- 4. Phone App available for parents on the go!
- 5. For a small convenience fee, parents can make secure online payments anytime, anywhere.
- 6. Set up hassle-free automatic payments for each student.

Account Balances

Please review these processes with your students and *make sure you know* when they are purchasing lunch. Parents are responsible for keeping their students account up to date and are responsible for paying any negative balance at the end of each school year.

Meal and a la carte pricing

The cost for lunch for the 2019-2020 school year will be \$3.50/meal. Students can bring cash or use their School Café account to purchase meals. It must be exact change, as no cash changes hands. Any change owed will be applies to the student's account. A la carte items such as milk, water, juice, and extra portions may also be purchased using cash or School Café.

Applications are available in 7 different languages. Don't have access to a computer? Paper copies are available in the Corpus Christi main office. All free and reduced school meal applications from the last school year will expire in October. This means families must submit a new school meal application for the current school year in order to be eligible for the entire school year. The meal application is completely confidential. Free or reduced eligibility is based on income eligibility guidelines that are determined by the United States Department of Agriculture.
