Our basic financial policy is the following:

FULL PAYMENT IS DUE AT THE TIME OF SERVICE UNLESS OTHER ARRANGEMENTS HAVE BEEN MADE WITH OUR OFFICE MANAGER.

WE ACCEPT CASH, CHECK, VISA or MASTERCARD

ADULT PATIENTS

Adult patients are responsible for full payment at the time of service unless specific arrangements are made prior to the start of treatment.

MINOR PATIENTS

The adult accompanying a minor and the parents/guardians are responsible for full payment at time of service. For unaccompanied minors, non-emergency treatment will be denied unless charges have been pre-authorized to by Visa/Mastercard or by cash, check at time of service has been verified.

REGARDING INSURANCE

Full payment is required at time of service, we will accept assignment of participating insurance plans and will submit dental claims on our patient's behalf, and we will submit a refund for payment from an insurance company back to our patients in a timely fashion. We are not able to pre-determine or bill for insurance benefits only. A pre-treatment estimate will need to be submitted to your insurance company to determine the schedule of benefits for the services to be rendered.

Your insurance policy is a contract between you and your insurance company; we are not a party to that contract. Any insurance claim not settled within 90 days will be due in full. It's your responsibility to pay our practice in full for the treatment invoice.

Please be aware that some and perhaps all of the services provided may be non-covered services. You are responsible for the entire balance no matter what the outcome is with your insurance provider.

USUAL AND CUSTOMARY RATES

Our practice is committed to providing the best treatment for our patients and we charge what is usual and customary for the quality of the treatment that is rendered. You are responsible for payment regardless of any insurance company's arbitrary determination of usual and customary rates. We will do all that is reasonable and proper to have you receive the maximum insurance benefits you are entitled to.

PATIENT RESPONSIBILITY AND ADDITIONAL TERMS

Accounts unpaid after 60 days from day of service are subject to a delinquent fee of \$35.00. Furthermore the unpaid balance is subject to a 1 ½% monthly (18% Annual) finance charge. If we have to submit your unpaid account to a collections process you will be responsible for all charges our practice incurs; including collection fees, court costs and reasonable attorney's fees.

MISSED OR LATE APPOINTMENTS/RETURNED CHECKS

Unless appointments are cancelled at least 24 hours in advanced, our policy is to charge for missed appointments. You will be charged a \$50.00 **non-refundable** fee. Showing up 30 minutes late for a scheduled, confirmed appointment will carry the same \$50.00 **non-refundable** fee. Any returned check will carry a \$40.00 fee.
