- 1) Review minutes from 2013 annual meeting
 - a. Meeting minutes were accepted and approved
- 2) 2013 Updates and Decisions
 - a. Pool sign installed
 - b. Crumbling wall at pond repaired

- 3) Discussion
 - a. Sidewalk at Trillium still in need of repair as well as path clean-up. The board will address this with Dominion Homes.

7) Open Forum

- c. Questions and discussion regarding dead and dying trees behind Trillium. Need to be removed before they fall and cause damage. Suggestion to remove one/two a year because of expense. Board will review.
- d. Question about path upkeep and possibility of Township taking responsibility for maintenance. Township will not take responsibility for this. They see no benefit in doing so. It remains Summerfield Homeowners Association responsibility.
- e. Question regarding any policy regarding alcoholic beverages at pool. We do not have any policy regarding this-only that glass is prohibited at pool.
- f. Recommendation that information regarding radon be communicated to residents. Many home do have high levels of radon. The board will communicate information regarding radon.
