Requirements:

- 1. Be between the ages of 13 18.
- 2. Ability to pass a background check.
- 3. Have at least a "C" or 3.0 grade point average on the last report card.
- 4. Progress report(s) from school with no negative behavioral problems.
- 5. Have no serious arrests or convictions.
- 6. Able to provide 2 letters of reference.
- 7. Recruits under 18 but graduated from high school must show a diploma, high school equivalency or GED.
- 8. Be able to physical participate in drills and physical tasks.

Application Process:

- Applicants must fill out an application either online or by mail. Applications can be obtained in the forms section by going to <u>www.FFROA.org</u>.
 Download the application. Once complete, email the application and all pertaining documents to <u>LEOCode4Info@gmail.com</u>. A representative will communicate with you shortly.
- 2. Once the application is processed, the applicant will go through an interview process that includes the Recruit, Parent/Guardian and Board Members. At that time the applicant will be fingerprinted.
- 3. The application package will be submitted for a background & reference check. Once complete the applicant will be informed if they are approved. Further instructions will be presented at that time.
