WHAT ARE MILLAGES, AND WHY ARE THEY ESSENTIAL FOR STRONG PUBLIC TRANSIT?

A millage is a local investment that helps keep our community moving. Millage funding allows transit agencies to provide reliable transportation services, maintain and expand routes, improve technology, and secure additional state and federal funding. When we invest locally, we receive greater returns through better service, increased accessibility, and expanded opportunities for everyone.

Voter-approved millage funds are used strictly for bus operations. No millage funding will be used for building or facility construction. All vote funding goes toward keeping buses running. Public transportation benefits everyone by **reducing traffic, supporting local businesses,** and providing access to **medical care, education, and employment.** It also promotes **mobility and independence** for people of all ages and abilities.

The Shiawassee Area Transportation Agency (**SATA**) began operations in 2000 as an open-door public transportation system, meaning anyone can use the service.

Riders may call in advance to schedule transportation. Today, SATA serves a diverse community of riders including people of all ages, individuals with disabilities, employees, and local business patrons.
