EXCLUSIVITY + ELITISM
<ul> <li>□ The group's teachings are the ultimate truth that cannot be questioned.</li> <li>□ The group's teachings offer the only path to self-actualization and/or the afterlife.</li> <li>□ The group has sacred texts and rules that are resistant to change.</li> <li>□ The group is a utopian community where all needs can/should be met.</li> <li>□ The group has a special calling or destiny that must be achieved.</li> <li>□ The group uses special language that only insiders understand.</li> <li>□ The group or deity's authority supersedes that of any secular government.</li> <li>□ The group or deity is not subject to the laws of science or recorded history.</li> <li>□ Group leaders possess special wisdom that makes them spiritually elite.</li> <li>□ Those who reject the group's teachings are pitied or mocked within the group.</li> <li>□ Group members are tasked with rescuing outsiders from their ignorance.</li> </ul>
FEAR + SHAME CULTIVATION
<ul> <li>Exclusion from the group will result in eternal suffering or annihilation.</li> <li>Humans are fundamentally broken and inadequate on their own.</li> <li>Evil influences seek to corrupt or seduce members away from the group.</li> <li>The body's natural instincts are evil and cannot be trusted.</li> <li>Unseen malicious spiritual forces pose a tangible threat.</li> <li>Eternal consequences for temporal behaviors are a constant threat.</li> <li>Personal suffering is seen as evidence of failure or inadequacy.</li> <li>Asserting autonomy or prioritizing personal well-being is considered selfish.</li> <li>Unfavored identities or groups are depicted as deviant and/or disgusting.</li> <li>Voicing doubt or dissent within the group is seen as a sign of evil or corruption.</li> <li>Group teachings warn of an impending end-times reckoning.</li> <li>Seemingly coincidental events indicate the diety's approval or disapproval.</li> <li>Loved ones who are not recruited to the group will be permanently cut off.</li> </ul>
INSULATION + CONFORMITY
<ul> <li>□ Acceptance within the group is contingent on obedience and conformity.</li> <li>□ Nonconformance is grounds for discipline, correction, or exclusion from the group.</li> <li>□ Contradictory teachings must be rejected, censored, or publicly denounced.</li> <li>□ Special efforts are made to protect children from outside influences.</li> <li>□ Close relationships with outsiders must be limited or completely cut off.</li> <li>□ Leadership status is limited to those who exemplify the group's ideals.</li> <li>□ Members are expected to routinely practice the group's rituals.</li> <li>□ Members are expected to make routine financial contributions to the group.</li> <li>□ Members are expected to report one another's non-conformance to leadership.</li> <li>□ Members are expected to recruit new members to the group regularly.</li> <li>□ Members are expected to practice confession and penance regularly.</li> <li>□ Members are expected to adhere to rigid rules regarding sex and sexuality.</li> <li>□ Members are expected to adhere to rigid gender role expectations.</li> </ul>
