



### **Top 5 Things **NOT** to Do on Your Next Virtual Job Interview**

1. Don't come unprepared. You need to have interview questions and answers ready. You are interviewing them, just as they are interviewing YOU. Asking questions are a great way to show the interviewer your interest.
