Mr Oursler was a visitor at this meeting and presented the Council with rates for insuring the City Hall, Garage etc. A Motion by Councilman Bishop and seconded by Councilman Ashe that the City take out a holding policy for at least \$2500. pending rerating of the City Buildings. This policy will show \$1800.00 on City Hall and \$200.00 on furnishings, \$100.00 on tool house and \$400.00 for tools and supplies. This motion was passed by a unanimous vote of the council.

The clerk was instructed to make copies of Sec. 8 of ordinance 4 pertaining to dogs running at large.

All of the new committees were instructed by Mayor Bishop that they should authorize purchases of Material or supplies for their respective departments before any purchases shall be made.

Mayor Bishop suggested that anyone desiring to work for the Town should register his name with Superintendent Gregor and, as there is a demand for labor Gregor will contact the committee whose


department the work is to be done.

The water committee was instructed to check of all past due water accounts and submit a list to the council that some method may be adopted to collect these past due bills and an effort made to keep all water accounts up to date.



Mayor Bishop announced the appointment of Carl Gregor as marshall for the Town of Skykomish.

Councilman Pasley made a motion that Carl Gregor be retained as Water Sup't. during the ensuing councilmatic term. This motion was seconded by Councilman Thompson and was carried by a unanimous vote of the Council.

The Council agreed to rent the city hall on Sept. 10th and November 5th 1940 for the primary and General Elections. The clerk was instructed to mail the County Auditor a copy of the lease granting the use of the hall on these dates.

Supt Gregor reported that he has hauled 60 yards of gravel from Luther Proffitts at cost of .05 per yard.

A motion was made by Councilman Handy and seconded by Councilman Thompson that a concrete cross walk near the school be installed. This motion was passed by a unanimous vote of the council.

Councilman Pasley made a motion that the city purchase another 20 barrels of oil to finish oiling the city streets. Motion was seconded by Councilman Ashe and passed by a unanimous vote of the council.

Mayor Bishop named Norman McIntyre as City Police Judge and suggested that the First National Bank of Monroe be designated as the official depository for the Town of Skykomish. A motion was made by Councilman Handy and seconded by Councilman Ashe that the First National Bank of Monroe be made the official depository of the Town of Skykomish. Motion passed by unanimous vote of the council.

Mr. Gardner, State Examiner gave his opinion regarding city water collections. He stated that the city had no legal right

to extend credit to anyone for water service and that an effort should be made to collect all outstanding water bills at once.

Councilman Ashe made a suggestion that a form letter be sent to all delinquent water accounts. The water committee was instructed to meet at the city hall on Tuesday July 2nd and draw up a form letter to be sent to all delinquent accounts.

Mayor Bishop made a report regarding the water line at the mill. He stated that the water is dirty and instructed the water sup't. to flush out the line.

It was suggested that the Water Sup't keep close watch on the Reservoir and notify the clerk to post notices of water restrictions when necessary. This is to be strictly enforced.

A motion was made by Pasley and seconded by Thompson that this the meeting stand adjourned. Motion carried.

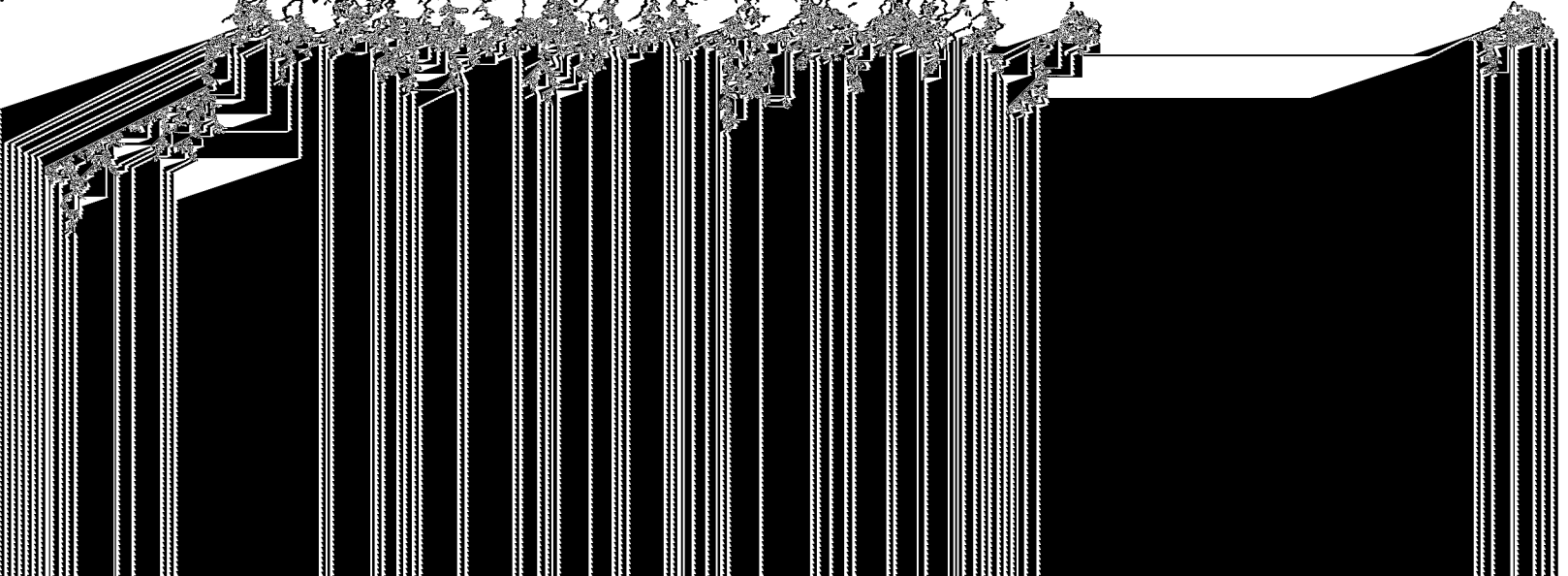

Mr. Ambrose of the Washington Corragated Pipe Co. was present at this meeting to discuss with the Council on 48" iron pipe. A Motion was made by Council Pasley that this matter be taken up at a later time, when a price on the fill can be received. Motion was seconded by Councilman Handy.

A Motion was made by Councilman Ashe and seconded by Councilman Thompson that the following Resolution be Adopted:
 Be IT RESOLVED by the Town of Skykomish, that the Town of Skykomish is opposed to the bill of electing Clerks and Attorneys of fourth class rather than appointing them.
 This resolution was sent at the request of Ass. of Washington Cities. Motion passed by unimous vote of the Council.

The Street Committee reported on the completion of the culbert by the Shadows. Councilman Pasley suggested that four reflectors be placed on the side wall of the culberts



Clerk was instructed to contact John Walkup of the Census Bureau in regards to the census of the Town of Skykomish.

Clerk was instructed to write the Ass. of Washington Cities for information on liability and property insurance on city fire trucks.

Being no further business a motion was made by Councilman Pasley and seconded by Councilman Neiland that we adjourn. Motion carried by unanimous vote of the Council.

The Town Council appointed Dr. Carl Martin as city Health Officer for the Town of Skykomish.

Meeting called to order by Mayor Bishop.

Councilmen present: Pasley, Neiland, Ashe, Thompson and Handy.

This special meeting was called for the purpose of coming to a conclusion on the proposed removing of the two bridges and replacing with a fill at 5th Street and East Highway.

Councilman Handy reported on his findings with Mr Furnbush of the State Highway Department, their estimate on this construction being 740 dollars.

Councilman Pasley made a motion and was seconded by Councilman Handy that the following resolution be adopted:

WHEREAS it is deemed necessary by the Council of the Town of Skykomish to improve certain city streets by removing two bridges and replacing with culverts and fill at 5th street and Highway East.
NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED; that said improvement be done by day labor method as provided for in Chapter #187 of the Session Laws of 1937, State of Washington and that the sum of \$740.00 be set aside to perform this work.

This motion was passed by unanimous vote of Council.

The Clerk read a letter from the Ass, of Washington Cities in regards to Liability and Property insurance of city fire trucks.

Motion was made by Councilman Handy and seconded by Councilman Pasley that the Town of Skykomish carry Liability and Property damage on the fire trucks of the Town of Skykomish.
