# 911 MEMORIAL




One of the very first projects we did in class. We were assigned to create a site plan that shows your idea for a 911-Memorial monument that would be constructed on campus.

the falling shapes by stacking them.




## The Craft


Based off of the 2010 game minecraft where



Based off of the cool math game

can move on.




# MIDTERM






# PERSPECTIVE
