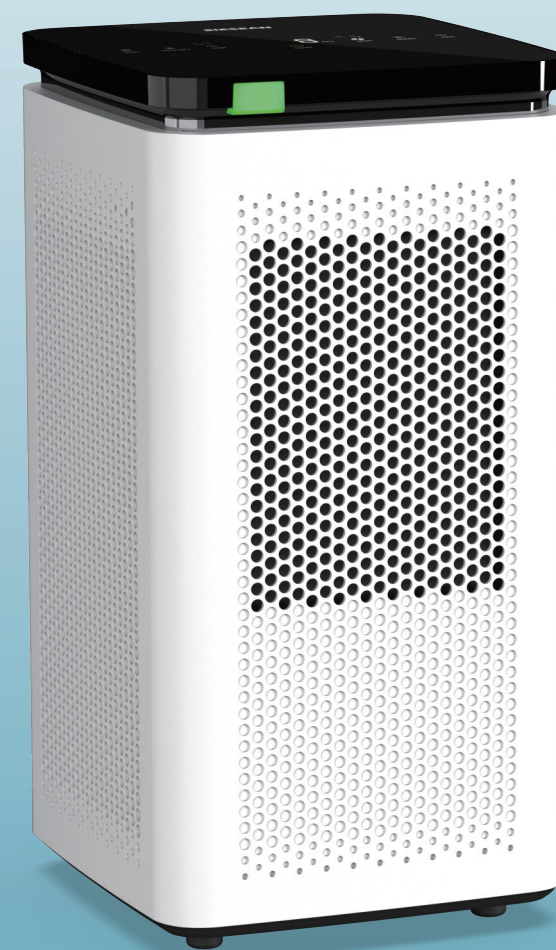

Safety Information

READ AND SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS

To reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, or other injury, follow all instructions and safety guidelines.

General Safety

- Only use your air purifier as described in this manual.
- **Do not use without removing the plastic wrap from the filter.**
The air purifier will not filter air and may overheat, causing a fire hazard.
- Do not use your air purifier outdoors.
- Keep your air purifier away from water, and wet or damp areas.
Never place in water or liquid.
- Do not use in excessively humid areas.
- Keep your air purifier away from heat sources.
- Do not use where combustible gases, vapors, metallic dust, aerosol (spray) products, or fumes from industrial oil are present.
- Keep 3.28 ft / 1 m away from where oxygen is being administered.
- Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the air purifier.
- Do not allow children to play with the plastic packaging. Immediately discard the plastic after unwrapping the filter.
- Do not place anything into any opening on the air purifier.
- Children should be supervised to ensure they do not insert fingers or objects into the vent openings.
- **WARNING: To Reduce The Risk Of Fire, Electric Shock Or Injury To Persons, Do Not Use Replacement Parts That Have Not Been Recommended By The Manufacturer (e.g. Parts Made At Home Using A 3D Printer).**
- Do not sit or place heavy objects on the air purifier.
- Keep the inside of the air purifier dry. To prevent moisture build up, avoid placing in rooms with major temperature changes.
- Always unplug your air purifier before servicing ,cleaning or any other maintenances(such as changing the filter).

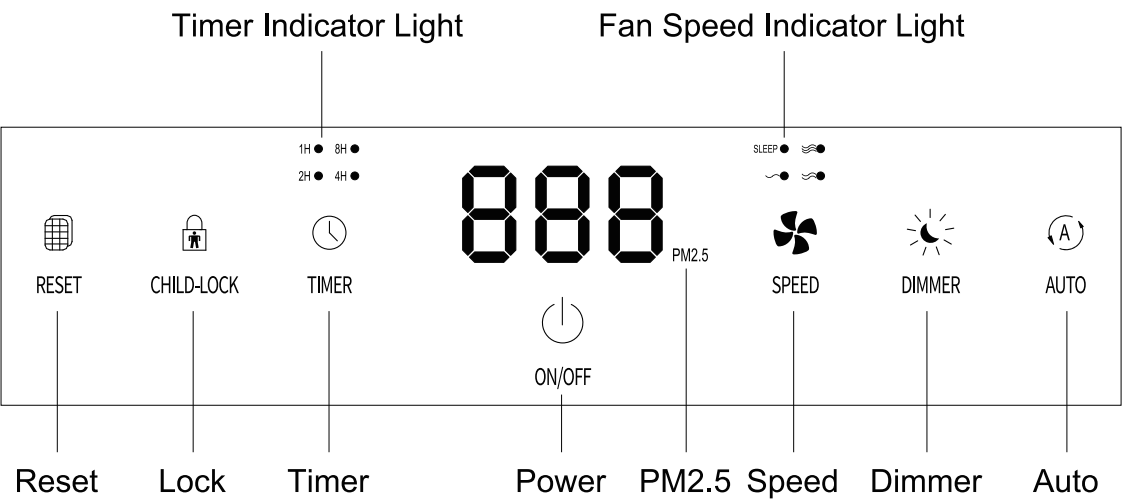
- Do not use your air purifier if it is damaged or not working correctly, or if the cord or plug is damaged. Do not try to repair it yourself. Contact Customer Support.
 - **WARNING:** To reduce the risk of fire or electric shock, do not use this air purifier with any solid-state speed controls (such as a dimmer switch).
 - Children should not clean or perform maintenance on the air purifier without supervision.
 - This air purifier is not to be used by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory, or mental capacities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning the use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
 - Not for commercial use. Household use only.
- This appliance has a polarized plug (one blade is wider than the other). To reduce the risk of electric shock, this plug is intended to fit in a polarized outlet only one way. If the plug does not fit fully in the outlet, reverse the plug. If it still does not fit, contact a qualified electrician. Do not attempt to defeat this safety feature

Power Adapter & Cord

- Keep the air purifier near the outlet it is plugged into.
- Never place the cord near any heat source.
- Do not cover the cord with a rug, carpet, or other covering.
- Do not place the cord under furniture or appliances.
- Keep the cord out of areas where people walk often. Place the cord where it will not be tripped over.
- This air purifier is only to be used with the power supply adapter provided with the air purifier.
- This air purifier's power adapter uses standard North American 120V, 60Hz outlets. If using outside the US or Canada, check for compatibility.

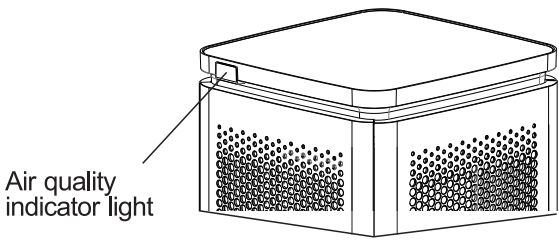
Getting to Know Your Air Purifier Controls

Control Panel



Air Quality Indicator Light

	Green	Good
	Yellow	Moderate
	Red	Bad



Automatic Mode



After turning on the power, the built-in air quality sensor will automatically detect the indoor air quality. When automatic mode is activated, the air purifier will select the most appropriate fan speed based on the measured air quality .

Child-Lock



Press the child-lock button and hold it down for 3s and all functional buttons will be locked.

Press and hold down again the child-lock button for 3s and all functional buttons will be unlocked.

Timer



The timer button sets the running time to 1, 2, 4, or 8 hours, then automatically shuts off the unit and turns off the corresponding indicator light.

Reset



Press the button for 3 seconds to reset the unit.(This function is only available when the air purifier prompts to replace the filter).

Sleep Mode



In sleep mode, the unit runs at low speed with less noise.

Dimmer



Used for adjusting the brightness of indication light(four brightness adjustable)

At night, you can use the dimmer to adjust the light to four brightness.

Fan Speed



The fan speed can be selected from the level 1, the level 2, the Level 3, and the sleep mode, then the corresponding indicator light is on.

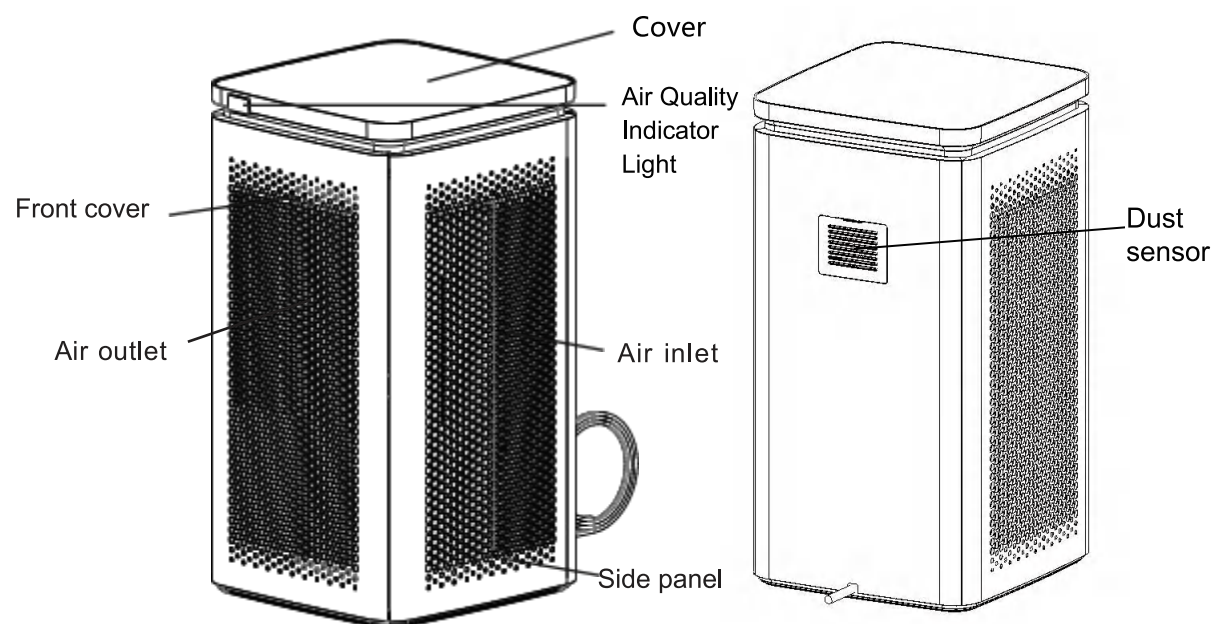

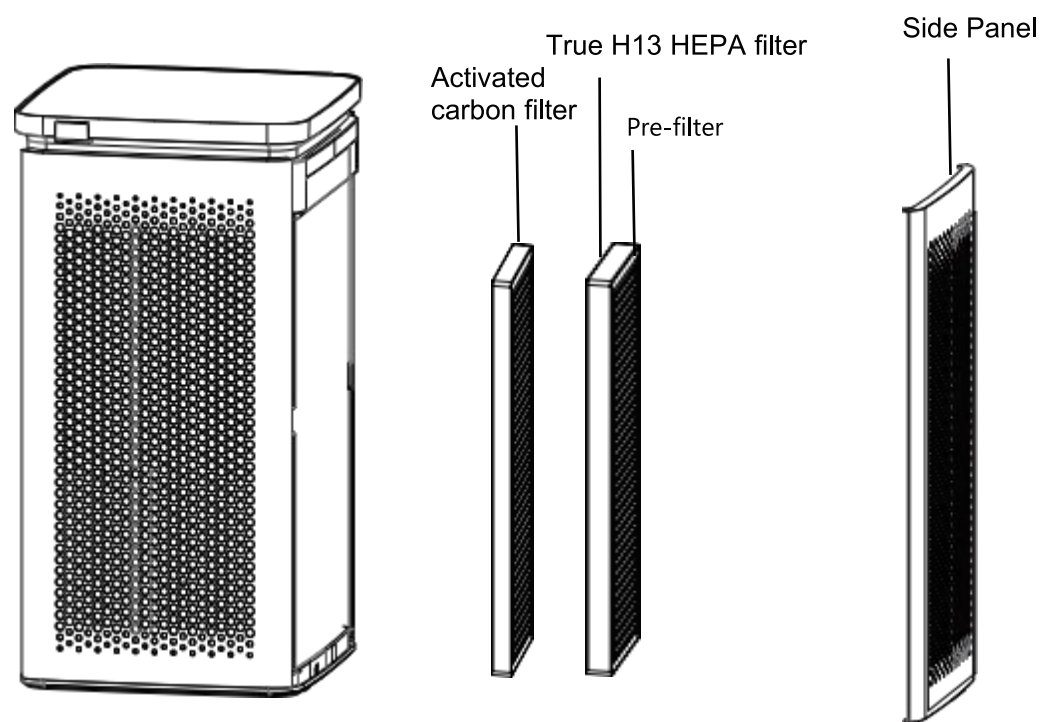

Getting Started



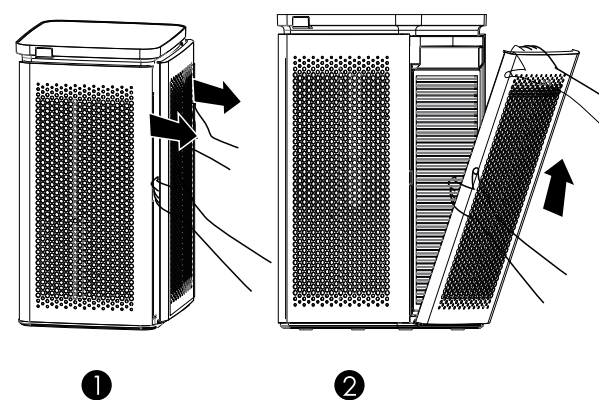
Composition of high-efficiency filter



Remove and install the filter cover

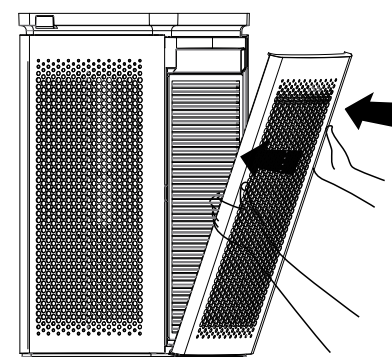
1 Remove the filter cover

Grip the upper half of the filter cover from the air inlets on both sides of the unit and pull it outward. Then pull the cover upwards lightly.



2 Install the filter cover

Reinstall the filter cover, and align them with both sides of the air purifier. And put the fixed rod at the bottom of the panel into the groove at the bottom and then gently push them flat.



Using Your Air Purifier

The store place of air purifier

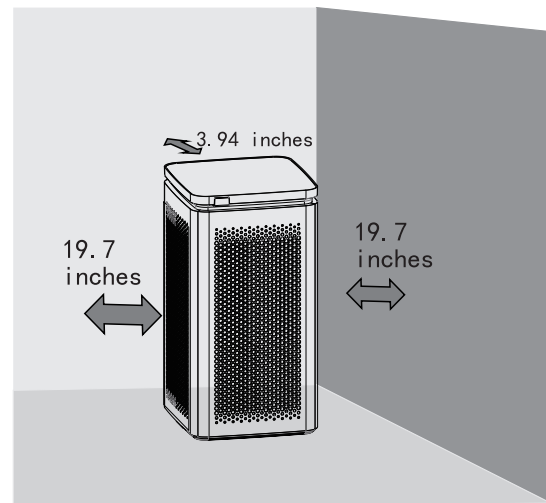
In order to achieve good air circulation in your room, make sure there is at least 19.7 inches clearance between the air inlets on both sides of each machine and the wall or curtain, and make sure that the air outlet at the back is at least 3.94 inches away from the clearance.

Please use it at least 3.28 ft away from TVs and radios.

Please do not plug the air purifier into the same socket as TV, radio or other electrical appliances. Otherwise, it is easy to cause a screen shake or noise.

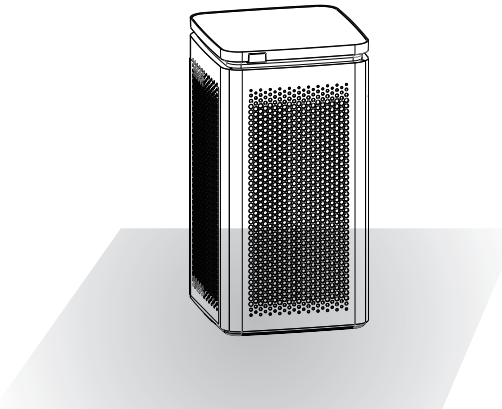
If it is used in the same place for a long time, the walls around the unit may be dirty.

Do not obstruct the air inlet and outlet to ensure adequate ventilation and maximum efficiency of the unit.

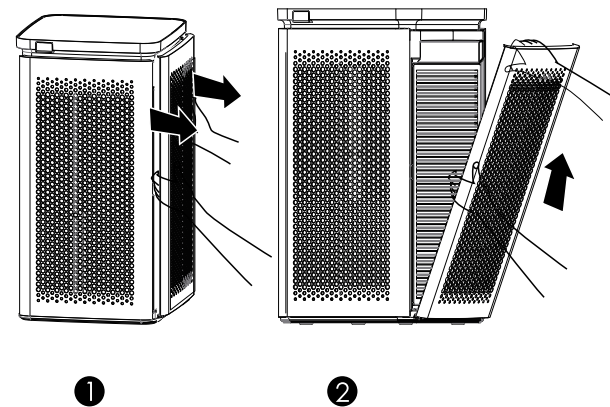


When the first time you use the air purifier, please follow the steps below to install the filter correctly.

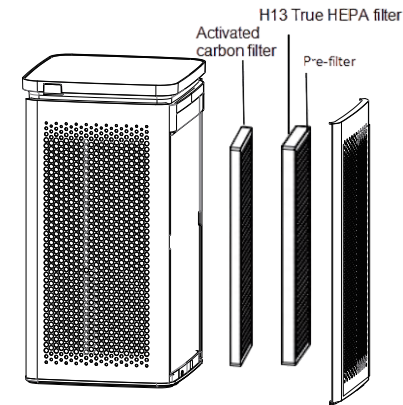
- 1 Remove the plastic packaging and then place the air purifier on a firm, dry and flat surface.



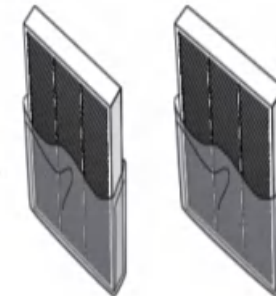
- 2 Grip the upper half of the filter cover from the air inlets on both sides of the unit and pull it outward. Then pull the cover upward slightly.



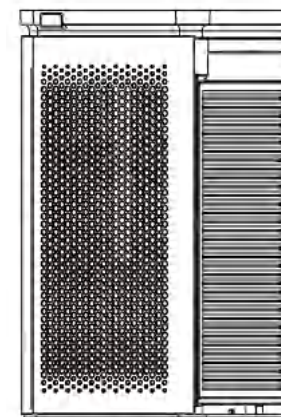
- 3 Remove the filter inside the purifier.



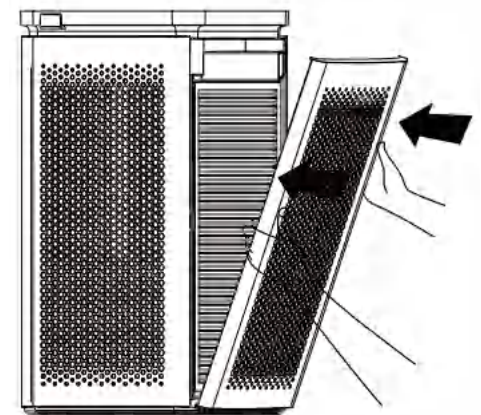
- 4 Remove the plastic packaging from the filter.



- 5 Install the high efficiency filters.



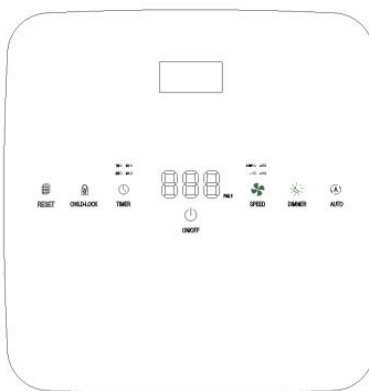
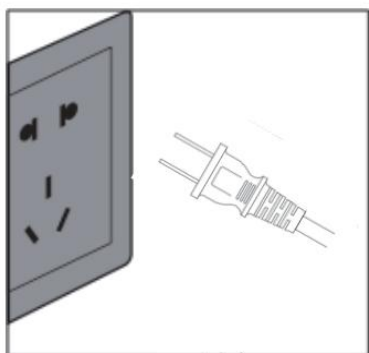
- 6 Reinstall the filter cover and align them with both sides of the air purifier. And put the fixed rod at the bottom of the panel into the groove at the bottom and then gently push them flat.



TIPS

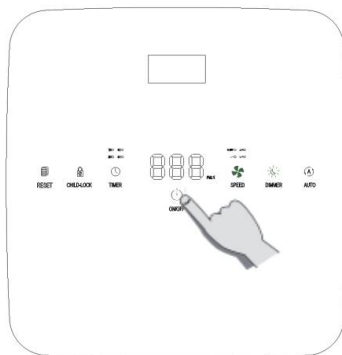
When installing the filter cover, please install them carefully to prevent your hands from being clipped.

7 Plug in the power cord



When connected to power, the device emits an audible tone, illuminates the power indicator with a steady red light, and enters standby mode.

8 Turn on the air purifier



With the unit powered on, pressing the power button triggers a 10-second countdown (10 to 0), engages automatic mode, and turns on the corresponding indicator light.

When the machine is turned on, the air quality indicator lights up at a slow speed.

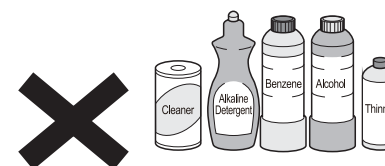
When default the automatic mode, the unit automatically detects the air quality while running.

Care and Maintenance

Be sure to cut off the power plug before cleaning the product.

Never soak the air purifier in water or any other liquid. Never use corrosive or inflammable cleaners such as bleach or alcohol to clean any part of the product.

Only the pre-filter and HEPA filter are designed to be cleanable; The activated carbon filter does not need to be cleaned.



Cleaning the air purifier

Regularly clean the inside and outside of the purifier to prevent dust from accumulating.

- 1 Wipe the dust off the purifier with a soft dry cloth.
- 2 Clean the air inlets and outlets with a soft dry cloth.

Cleaning the sensor

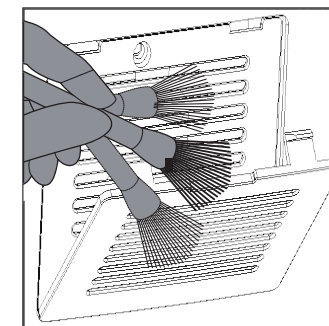
Clean the sensor every 2 months to ensure the purifier is running at peak performance. If the purifier is used in a dusty environment, please clean it frequently.

TIPS

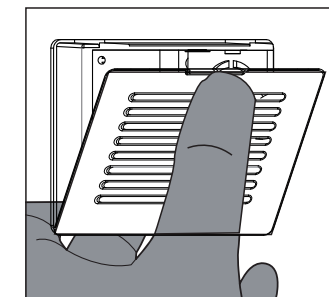
When the humidity in the room is very high, condensation may form on the sensor. So even if the air quality is good, the air quality indicator light may also indicate poor air quality, in which case you must clean the sensor or use either manual speed settings.

Note: How often you clean the dust sensor will depend on the air quality of your environment. If your air is often polluted with dust, dander, smoke, and other particles, you may need to clean your dust sensor more often.

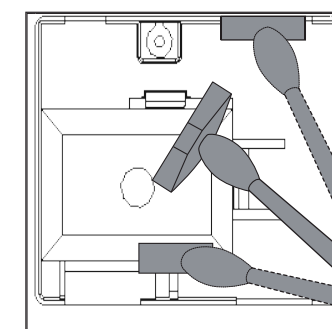
- 1 Use a soft brush to clean the air inlets or outlets of the sensor.



- 2 Use a small tool to gently pry open the sensor cover.



- 3 Use a slightly moistened swab to clean the sensor, air inlets and outlets.

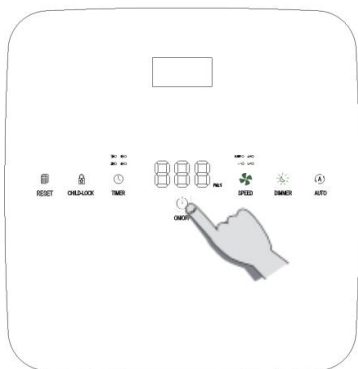


- 4 Wipe the sensor with a dry swab.

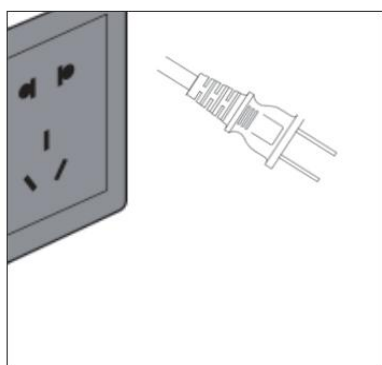
- 5 Reinstall the cover of the sensor.

Cleaning the filter

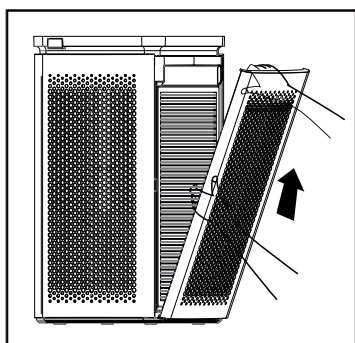
- 1 Turn off the power and power off the purifier.



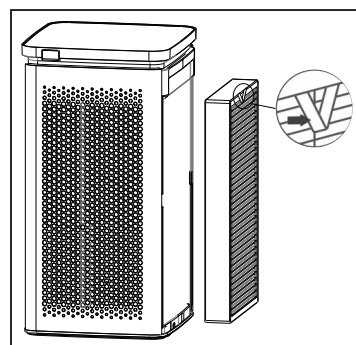
- 2 Cut off the power plug.



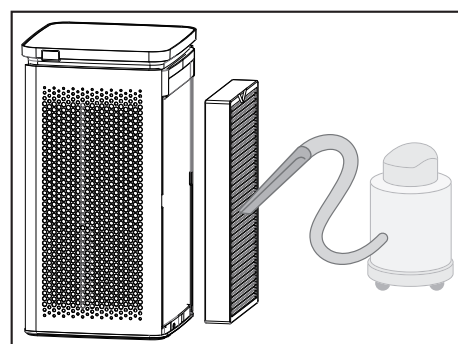
- 3 Grip the upper half of the filter cover from the air inlets on both sides of the unit and pull it outward. Then pull the cover upward slightly.



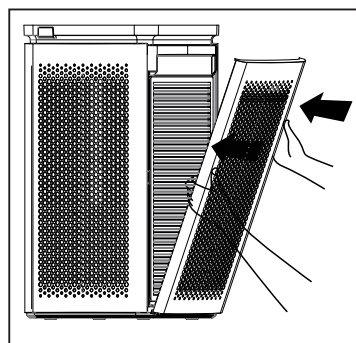
- 4 Remove the pre-filter by holding and pulling the short tab in the middle of the filter.



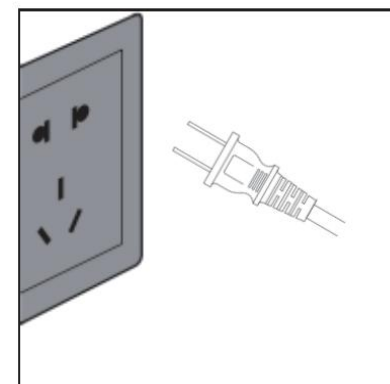
- 5 Gently vacuum surface dust using the low suction setting on your vacuum cleaner – taking care to avoid strong suction that could compromise the filter.



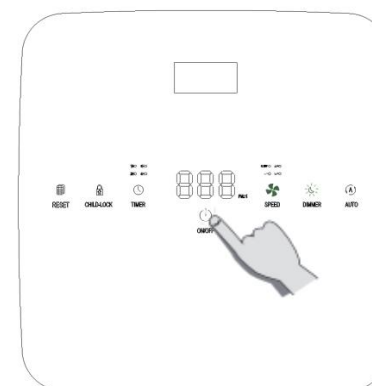
- 6 Reinstall the filter cover, and align them with both sides of the air purifier. And put the fixed rod at the bottom of the panel into the groove at the bottom and then gently push them flat.



- 7 Plug on the power.



- 8 Turn on the power and power on the purifier.



Replacing the filter

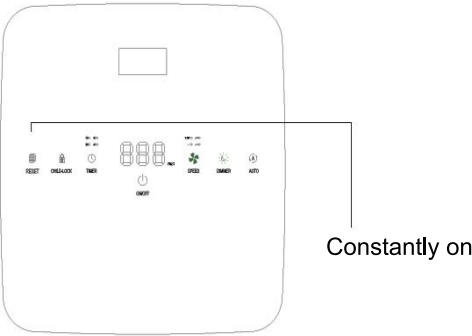
⚡ NOTE

Please power off and unplug the air purifier before replacing the filter.

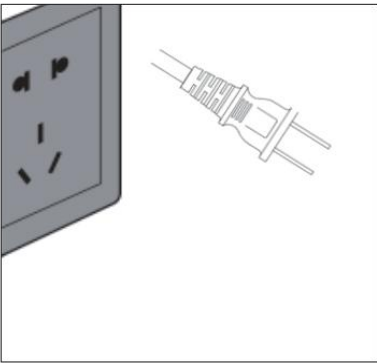
💬 TIPS

Remove the packaging of the filter before placing it in the air purifier and make sure that the side of the filter with label faces outwards.

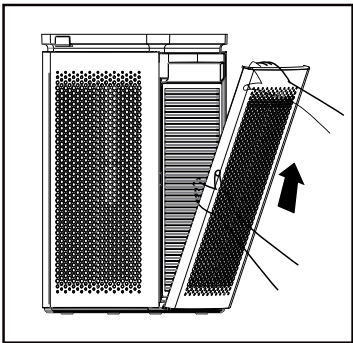
1 Reminds to replace the filter.



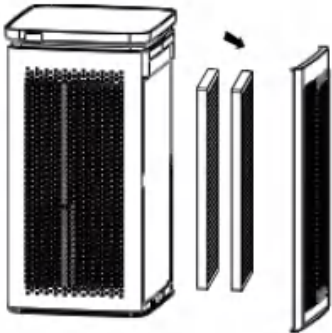
2 Power off and unplug the air purifier.



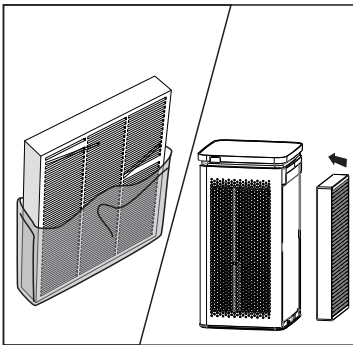
3 Grip the air inlet plate on both sides of the air purifier, pull the side plate outward and then gently pull out the side plate upward.



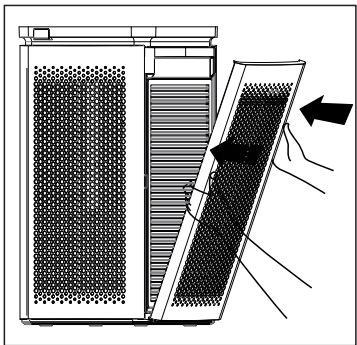
4 Remove the Filters inside the air purifier



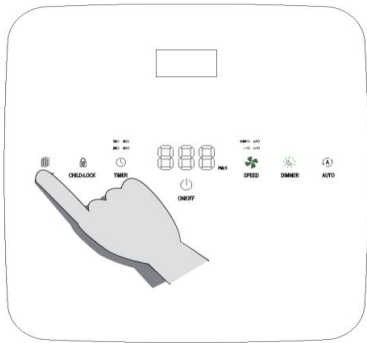
5 Remove all packaging from the filters and put it back inside the air purifier.



6 Reinstall the filter cover, and align them with both sides of the air purifier. And put the fixed rod at the bottom of the panel into the groove at the bottom and then gently push them flat.



7 Replace the filter and plug in the power, then press and hold the reset button for 3 seconds to reset the air purifier.

Troubleshooting

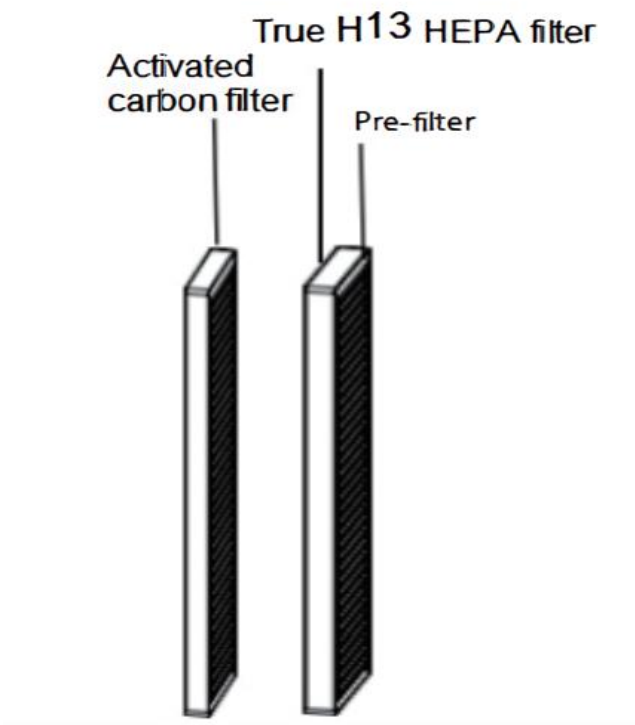

Problem	Cause	Solution
The air purifier does not work.	No indicator light or control panel does not light up.	1. Plug the power plug into the socket with normal power supply; 2. Check and ensure that the air inlet screen plate is installed in place.
	The control panel is on but the power button cannot be turned on.	Replace the control panel or its connecting cable or power board.
The purifying effect is insufficient.	The filter is dirty.	Clean or replace the filter.
	Air inlet or outlet is blocked.	Remove obstacles.
	Doors or windows are open.	Close doors and windows and close the curtains.
	Too much workspace.	Add a new air purifier.
Loud background noise.	The air purifier is not place on a flat surface.	Place the air purifier on a flat surface.
Motor does not turn.	Motor does not work.	Check the motor control circuit and replace the motor extension cable, control board connecting cable, motor, power board or control board.
Abnormal motor speed.	AUTO or SPEED indicator blink.	Check the motor control circuit and replace the motor extension cable, control board connecting cable, motor, power board or control board.
RGB Indicator Jump.	The RGB indicator remains green→yellow→red to cycle through the display.	Check PM2.5 sensor control circuit, replace PM2.5 sensor, control board or PM2.5 connecting wire.
