October traditionally has been the peak of hurricane season for Florida residents. This year, we have been mercifully spared from damage from the named storms. Unfortunately, our friends in Puerto Rico have not been as lucky. The city of Ponce, which is the home of Archbishop Garcia, the leader of the Anglican Church in America, was particularly hard hit. They had damage from both wind and from flooding. At this writing, a week after the storm had departed, most of the island is still without power and clean water. Rescue and repair efforts are greatly hindered. This area was also badly damaged by Hurricane Maria five years ago. They had barely finished their recovery from Maria when the new storm hit last

It must be disheartening for our friends to have to start over once again. Without their faith, it might be too much to bear. With our help, we can both lift their spirits and help them rebound from this latest disaster. You will be proud to know that St. Patrick's and our Diocese had already been making regular contributions to Puerto Rico with our monthly tithe.
