Isaiah 9:6

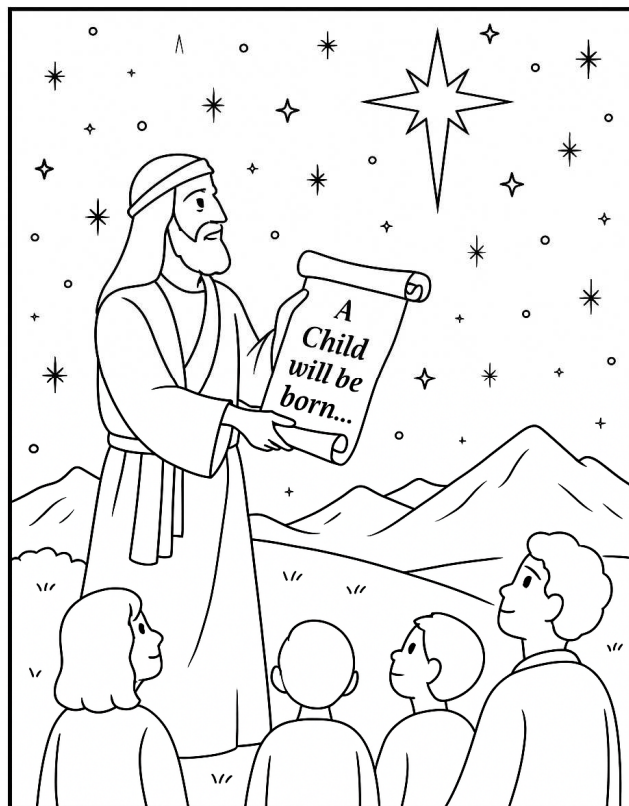
### Memory Verse (NKJV)

2. Why did Mary visit Elizabeth?
3. How can we have peace when we are uncertain or afraid?



## Week 3: Joy

### Memory Verse (NKJV)

### Discussion Questions

1. Why do you think God sent the angels to the shepherds first?
2. What does "good tidings of great joy" mean to you?
3. How can we share the joy of Jesus with others today?

Matthew 1:18–25

### Memory Verse (NKJV)

"And she will bring forth a Son, and you shall call His name JESUS, for He will save His people from their sins." – Matthew 1:21

### Discussion Questions

1. How does the birth of Jesus show God's love for us?
2. What do Mary and Joseph teach us about trusting God?
3. How can we show God's love to others during Advent and Christmas?
