

Activity Printable "Wedding at Cana Board Game"

The Wedding at Cana (Cutout)



Directions: Place markers anywhere on the board. Roll the die and move that many spaces clockwise. Follow the directions on the space you land on. If you land on a "?", the player to your left draws a card and reads it out loud. If you answer the question correctly, you receive a jar. If you land on a "Take A Jar", you can take a jar from any player. If you land on "Lose A Jar", you must return a jar.

If you land on "Give A Jar Away", you must give one of your jars to a player. Players work their way around the board and try to collect jars. The first player to collect 6 jars wins. Continue playing to find out who comes in second, third, fourth, etc.

Directions- Print out Directions, cut it out, and glue on the front of a file folder.

Game Board- Print out the Game Board, trim it, and glue it inside the file folder. Make sure the directions are on the front of the file folder. Laminate or cover with clear contact paper to make it last.

Question Cards- Use these cards or make your own. Print out Question Cards. Use only the cards that reflect your student's abilities. Laminate or cover with clear contact paper to make them last.

Tokens- Use these tokens or make your own. Print out several pages of Tokens on card stock. Cut out Tokens. Laminate or cover with clear contact paper to make them last.

<p>Jesus said this had not yet come. (My hour.)</p>	<p>Who tasted the water that had become wine? (The headwaiter.)</p>

<p>Who knew the source of the special wine? (The servers.)</p>	<p>What did Jesus tell the servers to fill with jars with? (Water)</p>

("Fill the jars with water.")</p>	<p>The headwaiter called someone and said to him, "Everyone serves good wine first, and then when people have drunk freely, an inferior one; but you have kept the good wine until now." Who did he call? (The bridegroom.)</p>

<p>Who was with Jesus at the wedding? (His disciples and his mother, Mary)</p>	<p>How did the second wine taste? Better or worse? (It was better than the original wine.)</p>
