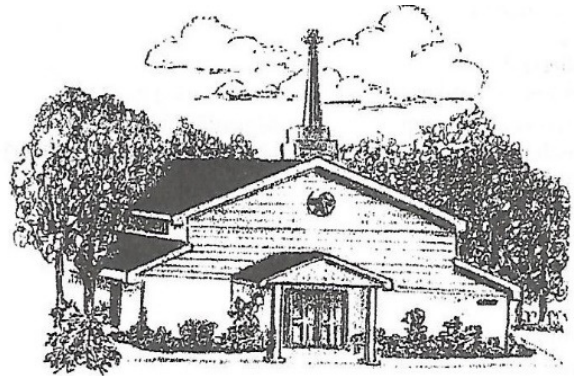

Ascension of Jesus
The Acts of the Apostles starts with the Ascension of Jesus up to Heaven to return to his Father, forty days after the Resurrection. We can read this account in Acts 1:6-11

Pentecost
 This was originally a Jewish Feast which occurred fifty days after the Passover. The Jews celebrated the first fruits of the corn harvest and in later times the giving of the Law to Moses. In the Christian Calendar, Pentecost falls fifty days after Easter.

While on earth, Jesus had promised to send the Paraclete or Comforter who would be with us all the time. This is the Holy Spirit who came upon the Apostles and Mary in the Upper Room, in the form of a wind and separated tongues of fire. The Apostles were empowered to go out to spread the Gospel (*See Acts 2:1-11*) We, as followers of Christ can also claim the Holy Spirit to have come upon us, both at Baptism and at our Confirmation. The Holy Spirit continues to come down on us when we do God's work on earth.
