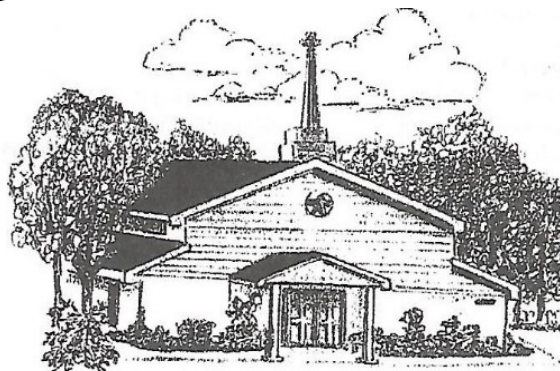

Letter from the Bishop:

Dear Parish Family:

The greatest gift that has been given to us is our faith. This faith is given to us by God. It is nurtured by our Christian Community.

Our faith is a gift which we are called upon to pass on to others. Pass this gift on with love and generosity.

The Church helps us to grow in our faith. The Church helps us to rise again when we fall. It is through the Church and its liturgical celebrations that we stay in communion with Christ our Lord and each other.

Imagine if the church were closed when you came to celebrate the Sunday Eucharist. You approach the door and your read a sign that says "SORRY, CLOSED DUE TO LACK OF PARTICIPATION". How sad you would feel.

Full participation in the life of the church means giving of our time, talent, and treasure. It also means inviting new people to join in our celebration of Christ's love for us.

Here are some questions which each of us ought to ask ourselves and to pray for God's guidance in our response.

TIME: How much time do I give my Church? (Do I make excuses? <I'm too busy> <Let someone else do it> <No one has ever asked me>).

TALENT: When was the last time I used my talent, which is God's gift to me, to help build up the body of Christ at St. Patrick's? (Some of the excuses we use; <Well, I use my talent to make a living> <I have too many other commitments> <My talents could not be used in a Church setting>).

TREASURE: Do I really give enough to the Church? Do I give until it hurts? (<I have so many bills> <The church is doing O.K. they don't need my money> <I work hard for every penny I have, why should I give it up> <10% you have got to be kidding>).
