Includes step-by-step instructions and materials for each week.

Week 1: Creation Wheel



Preparation:

- Using the diagram provided, mark the plates in 7 pie pieces for the students to color.
- For one plate per person, mark only 1 pie piece. *for the student to cut out
- See the separate PDF to design the pie plates and an example of the output.



Instructions:

1. Give each student two paper plates. On one plate, draw and label the 7 days of creation in pie sections.
2. On the second plate, cut out a pie-shaped window.
3. Place the top plate over the bottom one and fasten with a brad in the center.
4. Rotate to see each day of creation.

Materials Needed:

- 2 paper plates
- Scissors
- Markers/crayons
- Brass brad/fastener

Week 2: Serpent and Apple Mobile

Preparation:



- Print and cut out apple

Instructions:

1. Cut a spiral from a green paper plate to make a snake.
2. Decorate with eyes and tongue.
3. Attach red apple cutouts with verses or 'temptation vs. truth' examples.
4. Hang as a mobile.

Materials Needed:

- Green paper plates
- Red construction paper
- Scissors
- Markers
- String
- Hole punch



Week 3: Heart of Forgiveness



Preparation:

- Print and cut out hearts or use wooden hearts if available





Instructions:

1. Cut out heart shapes from red or pink paper, or use wooden hearts.
2. Inside, write or draw examples of kindness and forgiveness.
3. Decorate with stickers or stamps.



Materials Needed:

- Construction paper
- Scissors
- Markers
- Stickers/stamps



Week 4: Miniature Ark



Preparation:

- Print and cut out the rainbow




Instructions:

1. Give students craft sticks to glue into a boat shape.
2. Attach a paper rainbow and animal stickers or drawings inside.
3. Add a Genesis 9:13 verse tag.



Materials Needed:

- Craft sticks
- Glue
- Cardstock
- Animal stickers
- Rainbow template
- Markers



Week 5: Cup Tower Challenge

Preparation:

- None

Instructions:

1. Divide students into teams.
2. Use paper cups and straws to build the tallest tower possible in 10 minutes.
3. Discuss pride vs. teamwork.

Materials Needed:

- Paper cups
- Craft Sticks
- Timer
- Ruler for measuring



Week 6: Faith Journey Map

Preparation:

- None

Instructions:

1. On a brown paper bag or large paper, draw a map from Ur to Canaan.
2. Add symbols (tent, altar, stars, etc.) along the route.
3. Label key locations from Genesis 12.

Materials Needed:

- Brown paper bags or large paper
- Markers
- Stickers (optional)



Week 7: Starry Sky Promise



Preparation:

- None



Instructions:

1. Glue star shapes on black paper.
2. On each star, write part of God's promise to Abraham.
3. Add title and verse reference (Genesis 15:5).



Materials Needed:

- Black paper
- Gold/yellow stars
- Glue
- Markers

Promises God made to Abraham:

1. A Great Nation
 - a. Land – Land of Canaan – Israel
 - b. Numerous Descendants
2. A Great Name
 - a. Dynasty of Kings and lineage that would be the Messiah – Jesus
3. Blessings for all Families of the Earth
 - a. Promises of the priesthood and the Gospel, which would be a blessing to all of Abraham's posterity.
 - b. Eternal blessing

Week 8: 'God Provides' Banner



Preparation:

- Print and cut out baby Isaac and Abraham/Sarah/Isaac



Instructions:

1. Fold paper into a banner shape.
2. Write 'God Keeps His Promises' and draw baby Isaac.
3. Add decorations with stickers or glitter glue.



Materials Needed:

- Construction paper
- Markers
- Glue
- Stickers
- Glitter glue



Week 9: Ram in the Thicket Diorama

Preparation:


Print and cut out pictures of Abraham, Isaac, the altar, and Ram.

Instructions:

1. Use a shoebox or folded cardstock to make a scene.
2. Create cutout figures of Abraham, Isaac, the altar, and the ram.
3. Glue into place with background drawn or colored.

Materials Needed:

- Shoebox/cardstock
- Scissors
- Glue
- Crayons/markers



Week 10: Forgiveness Heart Chain



Preparation:

- None



Instructions:

1. Cut strips of paper and write one kind of forgiving action on each.
2. Loop into a chain.
3. Hang it in the classroom as a visual reminder.



Materials Needed:

- Construction paper
- Scissors
- Stapler or tape
- Markers

Week 11: Coat of Many Colors



Preparation:

- Print Coat of many colors – the teacher can cut out or students depending on age.




Instructions:

1. Cut out coat shapes from paper.
2. Decorate with fabric scraps, tissue paper, or crayons.
3. Write 'God is with me' on the back.



Materials Needed:

- Coat templates
- Fabric scraps/tissue
- Glue
- Scissors
- Markers



Week 12: Reunion Puppet Show



Preparation:

- Print and cut out pictures of Joseph and his brothers from PDF.



Instructions:

1. Make Joseph and his brothers using paper bags or cardstock puppets.
2. Students script a short skit showing forgiveness.
3. Perform for each other in small groups.



Materials Needed:

- Paper bags or cardstock
- Markers
- Scissors
- Glue
