EPIPHANY BLESSING: The Solemnity of the Epiphany is celebrated on Thursday January 6, 2022. On the feast of the Epiphany, or Little Christmas, it is a tradition to ask God to bless our homes.

This tradition (celebrated by Catholics, Anglicans, Lutherans, and Methodists) includes using chalk to trace four crosses, the initials of the three kings (Caspar, Melchior, and Balthazar) and the numerals of the current year over the doorway. It will look like this [20 + C + M + B + 22].
