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If He can feed five thousand, He can help you. Sometimes, things seem so impossible, for so much of our energy is wrapped up in earthly things, just like those disciples worrying about earthly food.

Yes, in all those things that lead us to cry out, "Why me?! It's too much! I can't put up with it! You have to take it away,"

we sound like the disciples: "Send the people away, for we can't feed them." It's impossible for me to patiently endure. I just can't do it.

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We live in a can-do culture that has infected even many churches. Jesus confronts us with the impossible to bring us to our knees, so that we cry out, "I can't! Even using everything I have, I can not do it."

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
