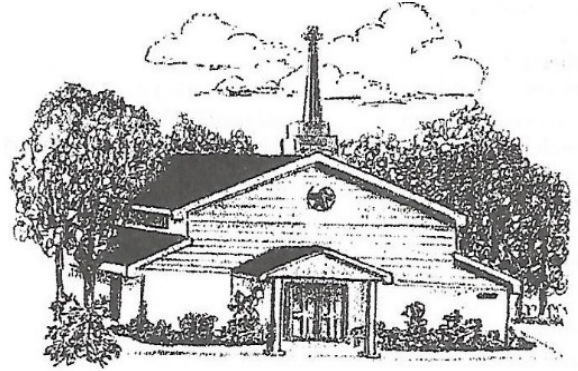
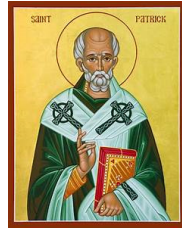

## Letter from the Bishop:

Dear Parish Family:

**TALENT:** When was the last time I used my talent, which is God's gift to me, to help build up the body of Christ at St. Patrick's? (Some of the excuses we use; Well, I use my talent to make a living I have too many other commitments. My talents could not be used in a Church setting).

**TREASURE:** Do I really give enough to the Church? Do I give until it hurts? (I have so many bills. The church is doing O.K. they don't need my money I work hard for every penny I have, why should I give it up 10% you have got to be kidding).
