



Dear Parish Family:

TREASURE: Do I really give enough to the Church? Do I give until it hurts? (I have so many bills. The church is doing O.K. they don't need my money I work hard for every penny I have, why should I give it up 10% you have got to be kidding).

Are you having a special Event?

You can rent the parish hall for birthday parties, baby/bridal showers, wedding receptions, anniversaries or any other special event the schedule of fees are:

- Parishioners: \$150. No clean up deposit
- Non-parishioners: \$300 plus \$350 refundable clean up deposit

The fees include a total of 6 hours. One hour set up. Four-hour party time and one hour clean up time. Additional time can be negotiated.
