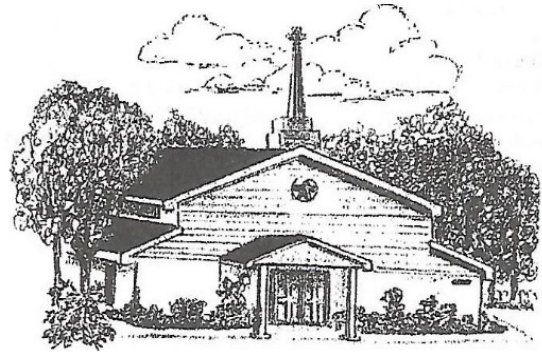

Fr. Michal's Musings for April

I have been proud of our congregation for the concern and assistance we have given to each other and to our communities during this difficult time. I have also been gratified to see that adaptation and ingenuity shown by St. Patrick's during our days of social distancing. We had 108 people follow the Passion Sunday Mass on the Facebook Live stream, and over 2000 tuned in to at least some portion of the broadcast since. Over 4,000 people came to our Facebook stream in the last two weeks. Regretfully, those accommodations of virtual attendance will have to continue through April.

For Palm Sunday, we will again broadcast the 10 AM service live on Facebook. It seems to work well for most of us, and I think those that had difficulty hearing can get better sound by adjusting their phone or computer settings. Fr. Chet and I will be available from 11:00 AM to noon on Sunday in the parking lot to distribute palms and offer Communion to those who would like to drive to the Church and receive in their cars. We will also broadcast the Good Friday meditations and Stations of the Cross on Facebook Live from noon until 3:00. Please check the website or Facebook page about the Easter Vigil service at 7:00 PM Saturday. On Easter Sunday at 10:00 AM we will stream the Easter service on Facebook Live. I believe we will also be able to have all the streamed service available for viewing on demand from the web site as well as Facebook. The rest of the April services will also follow the same format.


Of course, the Church's financial obligations don't disappear in these times. If you are able to continue your weekly giving, we will be glad to receive your offerings in the mail. We should also be able to set up electronic giving through the Facebook site sometime during the month. Also, we will decorate the altar with Easter lilies in memory of our loved ones who have passed before and with the hope that we will be reunited with them forever in the Resurrection. Please continue to send your Prayer requests by email, or call me on the Church line. God bless you all. Keep safe and well, and let the clergy know of any needs you have. We'll be here through the difficulties of this month and look forward to being with you all in person as soon as it is possible.
