Father Michael's Musing (Carolyn's Message)

The newly chosen President of Change Destiny has offered to match any offerings during this dinner campaign to continue supporting the Saturday Vocational Bible School for the children.

The backstory is: our introduction to Bishop John Kivuva while Fr Mike was in seminary began this ongoing outreach to Kenya. We initially gave the Bishop a dual current projector that he traveled to show the Jesus Tape all around Kenya and Tanzania. 70,000



lives were touched and it made him a very famous Bishop! He began a school in his hometown of Gilgil, Kenya. During his visit to Baltimore in 2015, Bishop John introduced us to Samson Karens and his wife, Alice Onzare. Samson was one of the street boys saved by the Bishop, who came to the US to finish his degree in theology. I assisted him setting up a 501c3 approved non-profit foundation named Change Destiny Life Africa, and currently sit on the board. www.changedestinylifeafrica.org

On **OCTOBER 2, 2021**, Fr. Mike and I invite all to a dinner in our Parish Hall at 6 PM to raise awareness and money for Change Destiny. Samson will present a slide show highlighting the children we support currently in Naivasha, Kenya, which is Rev. Samson Karen's home village. It costs \$50 a month to educate each student, and \$100 a week to run the Saturday Bible Study, which includes meals. What a change to their destiny our gifts can be!

Our prayer has always been, the more we Give to others, the more we are Blessed. We pray that you will all join us and are moved to give a love offering for this ministry, meet the founders and their children, and enjoy dinner in our Parish Hall!
