Father Michael's Musing

We begin September with the celebration of Labor Day. Work has always been an essential part of the Christian Tradition. Adam and Eve were given dominion over God's Creation. Dominion, as revealed through Jesus to His Apostles, means service and protection. Throughout the Old Testament and into the Gospels, God reminds us that we are to be good shepherds of his flock and faithful and fruitful servants in his vineyard.



It is no surprise then, that one of the most underrated consequences of our Covid experience has been the disruption of our work. Whether students at home or masked in school, or workers managing our

duties over Zoom, or merchants whose access to their customers has been compromised, we have all been frustrated in our desire to be fruitful. While the end of Covid will bring relief on many fronts, the hope to return to our work and to once again be fruitful and effective will be an underlying foundation of the normal lives we hope to resume.

It is no different in the Church. We know we are called to preach the Gospel, to be Christ's hands working in love as servants to the community, to be good shepherds and to be great teachers. Starting this month, St. Patrick's will begin in earnest to return to our chores. In person outreach may be slowed a while longer, but as the situation allows, our doors will be opened to welcome new guests and serve the community. Immediately though, we will return to the job of teaching the Scriptures to complement our celebration of the sacraments.

A wonderful Sunday School curriculum has been developed for our children that follows the Church calendar and illuminates both the Old Testament and New Testament lessons. Children's Sunday School will run from 9:00 to 9:40 every Sunday. Adult Sunday School will focus on the establishment of the Church as we study the Acts of the Apostles. Adult Sunday School will run from 9:00 to 9:40 Sunday mornings as well. Preparation for Confirmation and adult Baptism will be held after the 10:00 o'clock Mass, running from 11:00AM to 11:30AM Each of these programs will kick off on Sunday, September 12th and run through the end of October. In November and December, we will return to soup and study on Wednesday at 6:30PM, following the 6:00 Mass. We will have soup and bread for the body, and a Bible study for the soul. We look forward to welcoming the community back and doing the work that God has asked us to do, sharing our worship, serving the Community and spreading the Word.

Menu will include: Pancakes, scrambled eggs, hash browns, sausage, and bacon. Love Offering.


