

## Activity Printable: How to Use the Bible

Walk through the following steps with Students, the goal is to make the students familiar with searching the Bible and finding the Books, Chapters, and Verses.

1. Let's all find the **Table of Contents**.
2. What page in the **Old Testament** does the Book of Genesis start on? \_\_\_\_\_
3. The Books of the Bible for example Genesis are divided into **Chapters** which are noted by numbers in large print followed by verses which are numbers in lowercase. Can you locate the Book of **Genesis – Chapter 6 Verses 9**. What is this story about? \_\_\_\_\_
4. Now go back to the **Table of Contents** and locate the **New Testament**, what is the very first book in the New Testament? \_\_\_\_\_ This is a Gospel. The Gospels tell the story of Jesus' birth, life, death, and resurrection.
5. Can you locate the Book of Luke in the Table of Contents? What page does Luke start on? \_\_\_\_\_
6. Can you locate **Luke, Chapter 1 Verse 26 and 27**? What is this story about? \_\_\_\_\_
7. The way we see the Bible book name with the chapter and verse written in bulletins and books in the following format. Book Chapter: Verse - example: **Jonah 1: 17**. Look up **Jonah 1:17**, What is this story about? \_\_\_\_\_
8. More Practice: Look up the following Bible verses and note what they are about.
  - a. Acts 1: 9-11 \_\_\_\_\_
  - b. Mark 1: 9-11 \_\_\_\_\_
  - c. Mark 6: 37-38 \_\_\_\_\_
