International Zither Gathering 2026 - Invitation

Dear Zither Friends,

We are delighted to invite you to the **2026 International Zither Gathering (IZG)**, taking place **April 8–12, 2026**, in **Hanau-Steinheim, Germany** (near Frankfurt am Main). This special event is being organized by **Anne Prinz, USA** and **Tomy Temerson, Germany**.

The Gathering will bring together zither enthusiasts from around the world — from beginners to advanced players — to celebrate our shared love of zither music. Together, we will learn new techniques, exchange musical ideas, and enjoy the joy of playing and connecting in an international zither community.

Since our first announcement, we've received an enthusiastic response from zither players around the globe! **Thirty participants** from **five countries** have expressed their excitement by saying, "Yes," to coming to the event, and we hope you will be among them.

To make this event even more special, Anne spent time in Germany this fall scanning previously unperformed zither orchestra arrangements by **Mr. Gernot Sauter, which are now available**. Mr. Sauter created more arrangements for the zither than anyone else, and we're honored to showcase a variety of his musical styles, including Folk, Romantic, Classical, Jazz, Ragtime, and more.

Three months before the event, **Tomy will share a professional practice recording** from his sound studio so everyone can prepare with confidence.

For many years, we have organized seminars and workshops across different countries to encourage the growth of zither music and to build community through our shared passion. Now, we warmly invite you to join this international gathering in the country where zither music has its roots. We look forward to welcoming participants from **Austria, Japan, Germany, Switzerland, the USA, Canada**, and beyond!

Workshops - Participation Includes

- Your music for the workshops and concert as well as professional practice recordings by Tomy Temerson
- Orchestra workshops and rehearsals from Wednesday – Saturday, April 8–11.
- Public Zither Concert in the Kulturhalle Hanau-Steinheim on Sunday, April 12.

The cost for the seminar workshops is 195,- Euros.

Private Zither Lessons

During the seminar, we are happy to offer **45-minute private lessons** with **Tomy Temerson** and **Anne Prinz** (lessons for beginners will be available in English). If you would like to schedule a private lesson, please let us know in advance so we can reserve a time for you. If there is a high level of interest, we may invite an additional professional zither teacher to join us.

We look forward to helping you deepen your skills and enjoy personal guidance during the seminar! The fee for a private lesson is **40,- Euros per session**.

Zither Products

We are delighted to share that **Tomy Temerson** and **Anne Prinz** will present their **new line of zither products** at the Gathering! Participants will be the first to experience these exciting new instruments and accessories.

Throughout the event, there will also be ongoing exhibits featuring a variety of sheet music vendors, including Musikverlag Gernot Sauter – offering more than 4,600 pieces, from solos to full orchestra arrangements – as well as Psalteria Verlag and others.

Evening Events

We have some special evenings planned during our event. On **Wednesday evening, April 8, Tomy Temerson, will be providing a concert** for all participants and their guests in the old town of Steinheim at the **Old Parish Church of St. Johann**, which was built over 500 years ago. Tomy is looking forward to sharing his music with you in this beautiful church.

On **Thursday evening, April 9**, Tomy will be giving a workshop on **Zither Skills and Techniques, plus a Question-and-Answer** time for you to ask Tomy any zither technique questions you have wanted to learn. So, get your questions ready. We will ask you to submit them prior to the event.

On **Friday evening, April 10**, we invite you to join us for **dinner at a traditional German restaurant** with some great local food to order. We will have a **zither “open mic” night** after dinner for anyone interested in sharing their zither music with friends.

Sheet Music

All registered participants will receive the **seminar workshop sheet music 3 month prior to the event**. This is **included in your registration fee** and is yours to keep.

If you would like to have the **complete set of concert music**, it will be available for purchase for **50,-Euros**. The collection includes all pieces, all voices, and the full conductor's score, conveniently provided on a **flash drive**.

Please let us know by **March 30** if you would like to order a flash drive, so we can prepare it for you in advance.

Zithers for Loan:

For those traveling without their own instrument, we are happy to offer **zithers for loan** during the event. If you would like us to reserve one for you, please let us know when you register. The cost to borrow a zither is **50,-Euros**. Instruments from **Meinel, Wünsche, Volkmann**, and other makers will be available, depending on supply.

Hotel Accommodations:

To make your stay comfortable, a block of rooms has been reserved at both **Hotel Zur Linde**, and **Haus Anna an der Stadtmauer**, from **April 6–14, 2026**.

This gives participants traveling from afar a few extra days to **relax, explore, and enjoy this beautiful region of Germany** before and after the Gathering.

Both hotels offer free Wi-fi, parking, and they include breakfast each morning during your stay.

Single room (includes a twin size bed) is **104,-Euros per night**

Double room for two people (includes two twin beds) is **125,-Euros per night**

Reservation deadline for this rate at either hotel is February 20, 2026. If you have any issues making a reservation, please let us know. There are a limited number of Double rooms, so if they do not have a room for you, please let Anne Prinz know and she will assist you in making accommodations. The group block is under the name "IZG 2026." If you want to extend your stay longer, I am sure they will be able to assist you.

Travel Information

Airport:

The most convenient airport to fly into is **Frankfurt am Main Airport (FRA)**. It is the largest international airport near Hanau-Steinheim and offers many flight connections from around the world.

Taxi:

From the airport, it's about **29 kilometers (18 miles)** to the hotels. The trip takes approximately **25 minutes by taxi**, with an estimated fare of **70–90, Euros**.

Train:

You can also travel by train from **Frankfurt am Main Airport** to **Hanau Central Station**. The journey takes about **45 minutes** and costs around **9–18, Euros**.

From Hanau Central Station, you can take a **taxis, Uber, or Lyft** approximately 4.5 kilometers (3 miles) to reach **Hotel Zur Linde** or **Haus Anna an der Stadtmauer**.
