Please read this guide completely before using. Improper handling may result in product damage or an accident. Please keep this guide for future reference.


Capture Thought uses neodymium magnets. Neodymium magnets are the strongest, most powerful magnets on earth. They can jump together, pinch the skin and cause serious injuries. These magnets are not toys. Do not handle, play or swallow them. Keep neodymium magnets away from magnetic media, such as debit or credit cards as well as anyone with a pacemaker. The magnet at the top of the phone holder is specifically placed to be in front of a smartphone, not underneath it. The phone holder is designed to hold most smartphones up to 12 oz, any more weight and the arm could fail.

 Keep neodymium magnets away from magnetic media.


 Keep neodymium magnets away from your GPS and smartphone.

 Avoid contact with neodymium magnets if you have a nickel allergy.

 Neodymium magnets can become demagnetized at high temperatures.

 Neodymium magnet dust and powder are flammable.

 Neodymium magnets can corrode.

 Keep neodymium magnets away from anyone with a pacemaker.

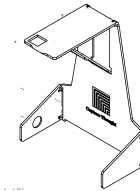

### Instructions

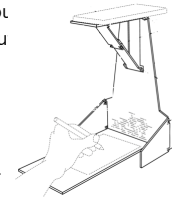
#### 1 SET UP

Separate the main body from the binder shelf and place the main body on a flat surface. Gently lift the phone holder until it snaps in place. Open the feet until they snap in place. (See diagram)



#### 2 CONNECT or RECORD

Open any video recording app on your smartphone, rotate your phone so that the camera lines up with the rectangular cut out and gently place your phone on top of the phone holder with the camera facing the floor. Tap record on your smartphone and begin recording or use any video conferencing app to connect with teachers, friends or tutors. You can use the whiteboard provided or any sheet of paper to record yourself.



#### 3 ARCHIVE or SHARE

Once you are finished recording, tap the record button on your phone to end your recording or call. Carefully remove your phone, edit if you prefer, then share your video or archive it for later recall.
