



The murder rates for Native relatives exceed the national average by over 10x, highlighting a pressing issue within Indigenous communities.



Homicide ranks as the 3rd leading cause of death among Native girls and women aged 10 to 24, and the 5th leading cause of death for Native women aged 25 to 34.



Insufficient data is a critical issue, as there is a lack of regularly reported concrete numbers regarding the missing and murdered Indigenous relatives.



Human trafficking and sexual violence does impact not only women but also young girls, young boys, men, and Two-Spirit individuals.
