

JK/SK HOME STOPS

- 1.1 All JK/SK students are eligible for bus loading and unloading at the pick up and drop off address on file at their respective school, unless safety hazards dictates that the bus cannot stop at the addressed location.
 - 1.1.1 Stop location safety will be determined by the Board, and in conjunction with Section D. 1.2. of the Joint Transportation Policy.
 - 1.1.2 Any student who is not assigned to a home stop due to safety may be required to walk to a suitable stop location.
- 1.2 Any JK/SK student who has a sibling living at the same residence, may be eligible to be assigned to the sibling's home stop if the sibling meets all of the following criteria;
 - i) The student must be attending a school that uses the Board to manage their Transportation services.
 - ii) The student is eligible for transportation as described in Section C. 3 of the Joint Transportation Policy.
 - iii) The student is assigned to the same school bus as the sibling who is eligible for a home stop.
 - iv) A request is made to NETBST by the student's respective school for the non JK/SK student to be assigned to the same bus stop location.
- 1.3 There will be a higher expectation that parents/guardians and students will adhere to the following responsibilities:
 - i) All students who are assigned to a Home Stop are subject to the same student responsibilities as outlined in Section D. 8 of the Joint Transportation Policy.
 - ii) All parents/guardians of students who are assigned to a home stop are subject to the same responsibilities as outlined in Section D. 7 of the Joint Transportation Policy.

Infraction will result the student being issued a School Bus Incident Report.
- 1.4 No other student will be eligible for a home stop unless they qualify as it is described in this section.
- 1.5 Any parent/guardian who wishes to walk or drive their home stop eligible student to or from school must report their consent to the student's respective school.
