Code of Conduct

You and your visitors must be respectful and follow our rules and Health & Safety guidelines that are detailed below. If there is a continued breach of rules and Health & Safety, we will take the necessary action to resolve, including the option to terminate any agreement.

Rules

- No Dogs on site
- Speed limit 15 km/h max & vehicles are to always remain on driveways or parking areas
- All gates are to remain closed at all times. Including Evans Road gate
- Evans Road gate is padlocked during daylight hours when no one is home
- Restricted access to all farm vehicles and buildings other than stables and hay sheds.
- All manure is to be removed from car park, yards and any other work areas on site
- No hay is to be fed in the carpark
- Please respect the facilities and clean up after yourself and your horse
- Be respectful to our other grazers
- Have fun 😊

Health & Safety

- Always wear a riding helmet and appropriate footwear when riding your horse
- Take every precaution to keep yourself, your horse and others safe
- Report all injuries, incidents or accidents
- Report all breakages
- Always ride within your capabilities
- All riders ride at their own risk
