Talbot Park Baptist Church could not exist without the above. Yet none of the above is the most important resource Talbot Park Baptist Church has, or for that matter any church has.

The most important resource a church has is its *people*. Together, you and I keep this place afloat. Our facility is still standing because you are willing to give to the cause of Christ what is rightly yours. But it is by no means just the money you contribute that sustains this church. It is, also, the family you are willing to build and become because of your faith in Jesus Christ.
