WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY

IN CONSIDERATION OF the risk of injury that exists while participating in ALL ACTIVITIES AT NATURE'S SCHOOLHOUSE NETWORK (hereinafter the "Activity"); and

IN CONSIDERATION OF my desire to participate in said Activity and being given the right to participate in same;

I HEREBY, for myself, my heirs, executors, administrators, assigns, or personal representatives (hereinafter collectively, "Releasor," "I" or "me", which terms shall also include Releasor's parents or guardian if Releasor is under 18 years of age), knowingly and voluntarily enter into this WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY and hereby waive any and all rights, claims or causes of action of any kind arising out of my participation in the Activity; and

I HEREBY release and forever discharge NATURE'S SCHOOLHOUSE NETWORK, LLC, located at 2185 Meadowlane Ave., West Melbourne, Florida 32904, their affiliates, managers, members, agents, attorneys, staff, volunteers, heirs, representatives, predecessors, successors and assigns (collectively "Releasees"), from any physical or psychological injury that I may suffer as a direct result of my participation in the aforementioned Activity.

I AM VOLUNTARILY PARTICIPATING IN THE AFOREMENTIONED ACTIVITY AND I AM PARTICIPATING IN THE ACTIVITY ENTIRELY AT MY OWN RISK. I AM AWARE OF THE RISKS ASSOCIATED WITH PARTICIPATING IN THIS ACTIVITY, WHICH MAY INCLUDE, BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO: PHYSICAL OR PSYCHOLOGICAL INJURY, PAIN, SUFFERING, ILLNESS, DISFIGUREMENT, TEMPORARY OR PERMANENT DISABILITY (INCLUDING PARALYSIS), ECONOMIC OR EMOTIONAL LOSS, AND DEATH. I UNDERSTAND THAT THESE INJURIES OR OUTCOMES MAY ARISE FROM MY OWN OR OTHERS' NEGLIGENCE, CONDITIONS RELATED TO TRAVEL TO AND FROM THE ACTIVITY, OR FROM CONDITIONS AT THE ACTIVITY LOCATION(S). NONETHELESS, I ASSUME ALL RELATED RISKS, BOTH KNOWN AND UNKNOWN TO ME, OF MY PARTICIPATION IN THIS ACTIVITY.

I FURTHER AGREE to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the Releasees against any and all claims, suits or actions of any kind whatsoever for liability, damages, compensation or otherwise brought by me or anyone on my behalf, including attorney's fees and any related costs.

I FURTHER ACKNOWLEDGE that Releasees are not responsible for errors, omissions, acts or failures to act of any party or entity conducting a specific event or activity on behalf of Releasees. In the event that I should require medical care or treatment, I authorize Nature's Schoolhouse Network, LLC to provide all emergency medical care deemed necessary, including but not limited to, first aid, CPR, the use of AEDs, emergency medical transport, and sharing of medical information with medical personnel. I further agree to assume all costs

involved and agree to be financially responsible for any costs incurred as a result of such treatment. I am aware and understand that I should carry my own health insurance.

I FURTHER ACKNOWLEDGE that this Activity may involve a test of a person's physical and mental limits and may carry with it the potential for death, serious injury, and property loss. I agree not to participate in the Activity unless I am medically able and properly trained, and I agree to abide by the decision of the Nature's Schoolhouse Network, LLC official or agent, regarding my approval to participate in the Activity.

I EXPRESSLY AGREE TO RELEASE AND DISCHARGE Nature's Schoolhouse Network, LLC AND ALL OF ITS AFFILIATES, MANAGERS, MEMBERS, AGENTS, ATTORNEYS, STAFF, VOLUNTEERS, HEIRS, REPRESENTATIVES, PREDECESSORS, SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS, FROM ANY AND ALL CLAIMS OR CAUSES OF ACTION AND I AGREE TO VOLUNTARILY GIVE UP OR WAIVE ANY RIGHT THAT I OTHERWISE HAVE TO BRING A LEGAL ACTION AGAINST Nature's Schoolhouse Network, LLC FOR PERSONAL INJURY OR PROPERTY DAMAGE.

To the extent that statute or case law does not prohibit releases for ordinary negligence, this release is also for such negligence on the part of Nature's Schoolhouse Network, LLC, its agents, and employees.

I agree that this Release shall be governed for all purposes by Florida law, without regard to any conflict of law principles. This Release supersedes any and all previous oral or written promises or other agreements.

In the event that any damage to equipment or facilities occurs as a result of my or my family's or my agent's willful actions, neglect or recklessness, I acknowledge and agree to be held liable for any and all costs associated with any such actions of neglect or recklessness.

THIS WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY SHALL REMAIN IN EFFECT FOR THE DURATION OF MY PARTICIPATION IN THE ACTIVITY, DURING THIS INITIAL AND ALL SUBSEQUENT EVENTS OF PARTICIPATION.

THIS AGREEMENT was entered into at arm's-length, without duress or coercion, and is to be interpreted as an agreement between two parties of equal bargaining strength. Both Participant, _____ and Nature's Schoolhouse Network, LLC agree that this agreement is clear and unambiguous as to its terms, and that no other evidence shall be used or admitted to alter or explain the terms of this agreement, but that it will be interpreted based on the language in accordance with the purposes for which it is entered into.

In the event that any provision contained within this Release of Liability shall be deemed to be severable or invalid, or if any term, condition, phrase or portion of this agreement shall be determined to be unlawful or otherwise unenforceable, the remainder of this agreement shall remain in full force and effect. If a court should find that any provision of this agreement to be

invalid or unenforceable, but that by limiting said provision it would become valid and enforceable, then said provision shall be deemed to be written, construed and enforced as so limited.

Nature's Schoolhouse Behavior Plan

Nature's Schoolhouse encourages a foundation of learning, social growth, and emotional development. Students will be guided with lessons that address respecting themselves, others and the environment, self-reliance, self-care, self-motivation, and stewardship.

NSN Ground Rules:

1. Be safe at all times in all places.
2. Respect yourself, others, and nature.
3. Work together to support each other's learning.
4. Show honesty and be trustworthy.
5. Demonstrate kindness to yourself and others the best you can.
6. Treat learning materials, indoors and out, with great respect and care. Return things to their place.
7. Follow the instructions of the staff. Let your teachers know if there are any problems you can't solve.

Guidance and Interventions: Teachers and staff may use a system of developmentally appropriate expectations and interventions, such as:

1. Setting Expectations – Teachers will share the ground rules and examples of acceptable behaviors.
2. Modeling – Teachers will model and reinforce appropriate, safe, and respectful behavior.
3. Supporting Positive Behavior – Teachers will redirect negative behavior by directing the child toward another activity or lesson that fosters the best in the child.
4. Problem Solving – Teachers will help facilitate problem solving and possible choices with the children.
5. Natural and Logical Consequences – Teachers may offer the child a natural or logical consequence. Depending on the severity of the harm or behavior, students may be dismissed for the day.
6. Regulation Spaces – Protecting the safety of children is very important. Children may use a self-regulation or co-regulation zone that is still supervised. At times it may be necessary to assist the child in regaining self-control.
7. Activity Replacement – When an activity is inappropriate for a particular child, that child will be redirected to an appropriate alternative activity.

Concerning Behavior: A child's behavior becomes a concern when his/her actions disrupt the safety or learning environment and affect the positive values and culture of Nature's Schoolhouse. For the safety and well-being of all, the following are examples of behaviors which will be addressed:

1. Intentionally and repeatedly disrupting the learning environment
2. Misuse or abuse of classroom or materials or playground equipment or any other school property

3. Intentionally not following directions in the classroom, in the outdoor classroom area or on the playground or campus
4. Not being honest, encouraging others to break rules or be dishonest
- 5 Showing rudeness or disrespect to others or the environment.
6. Physical aggression of any kind.
7. Verbal abuse or bullying of any kind.

Behavior Escalation Plan:

- 1) Educator speaks to the child about any negative behaviors taking place. The educator will try to support and give tools to help the child work through whatever is happening.
- 2) If negative behaviors continue to take place, the educator or parent/guardian may request a conference. Concerns and views will be respected. Each child will be treated individually and with respect.

If other children are involved in recurring incidents, the other child and their parents will be invited to meet as well.

A plan of action moving forward will be established during this meeting.

- 3) Plan of action will be executed during school hours.
- 4) If this plan is not being honored, another meeting will be called. The action plan may be adjusted.
- 5) If the child continues to show hurtful and/or disruptive behaviors, this child may be unenrolled from the program.

Parent/Guardian's Support Suggestions

1. Modeling: A parent is the most important teacher in a child's life. Children observe and often imitate. Demonstrating a variety of healthy responses to frustration and set-backs, as well as modeling effective problem-solving techniques and non-judgmental communication are especially valuable to young children who are still learning to establish their own self-control.
2. Discussion: Talking about ground rules (from home and Nature's Schoolhouse) with children in a positive manner. While children absorb a great deal by observation, discussing ways to show respect, build trust, show empathy, manage anger, and practice forgiveness can help a child build successful relationships.
3. Reinforcement: Acknowledge and reinforcement of positive behavior is always important and will help shape a child's behavior far better than criticism. Consider age-appropriate behaviors of respect, responsibility, and resourcefulness to develop agency and confidence.
4. Encouragement: Help your child to distinguish between appropriate "work/focus time" and "playtime" behavior; Maintaining a predictable routine to give children a sense of security and peace.

Nature's Schoolhouse Safety and Routines

- Please ensure your child walks safely through the parking lot at drop-off and pick-up.
- Remind students to not put anything in their mouths that isn't their own food. Discuss and show your child(ren) the red berries called Rosary Peas so they know to avoid them.
- We ask that each parent use the Procure app each day to check children in and out.
- Please do not leave your child(ren) unsupervised in your car or leave your car running.
- Students should be reminded to wash their hands before they eat or after handling "nature" or play items.
- Children should stay in view of their teacher when in the outdoor areas or nature.
- Remind students to tell their teacher right away if there is anyone who got hurt, something unusual or dangerous on campus.
- Sea Turtle students are asked to go to the bathroom with a buddy. Remind them to not go to another space without the staff knowing.
- Remind them to not touch items belonging to other students or the UUCB church's items or spaces.
