Annual members will receive a mailed renewal notice five months, three months, and one month prior to their subscription end date. Annual members with a valid email address will also receive an emailed renewal notice six months, four months, and two months prior to their subscription end date.

Annual members will receive a mailed lapsed notice one, three, and five months following their subscription end date.

Members now have the option to enroll in two beneficial programs. Once enrolled in either program, automatic payments are processed using the credit card information provided on the application. #### Service Officer



Comrades I would like to encourage any of you that fits into one of the following catagories to contact your local VSO (Veteran

Service Officer) about the VA's new Rapid Appeals Modernization Program (RAMP). (Personally, I recommend the Goose Creek Office.) You are eligible if you have a disability compensation appeal pending in one of the following legacy appeal stages:

Notice of Disagreement (NOD) Form 9, Appeal to Board of Veterans' Appeals (Board) Certified to the Board but not yet activated for a Board decision Remand from the Board to VBA.

Under RAMP, Veterans can expect to receive a review of the decision on their claim much faster than if they remain in the legacy appeals process. The program will allow participants the option to have their decisions reviewed in the Higher-Level Review or Supplemental Claim Lane outlined in the Appeals Modernization Act.

There are too many details about this program to give here. So I encourage you to contact a VSO and find out what your options are and what is best for you. Phone numbers and addresses to a VSO are online.



Dear VA Beneficiary,

We'd like to provide you with some important information about your VA benefit payments.

VA education, compensation, pension, and survivor's benefits are paid on a monthly basis. Normally, benefits for a particular month are paid the first business day of the following month. When the first business day of the month falls on a non-business day or a holiday, VA benefits will be paid on the last business day prior to the first of the month.

Provided below is the schedule for upcoming VA benefit payments:

Month	Payment Date	Day of the Week
May	June 1	Friday
June	June 29	Friday
July	August 1	Wednesday

You can check your latest VA benefit payments online using <u>eBenefits</u>. If you're not receiving benefit payments from VA, but know someone who is, please share this information with them.



#### VFW Patriotic Youth Scholarship Contest Opens

Every year, students compete for their share of \$3 million in scholarships and awards Dedicated to encouraging a better understanding and appreciation of America, the VFW's Voice of Democracy and

Patriot's Pen essay competitions help foster patriotism among today's youth. The programs also foster friendly competition as well as rewards success in the form of some \$3 million in scholarship monies being distributed.

The Voice of Democracy theme for 2018-19 asks high school students to reflect on <u>"Why My Vote Matters."</u> The audio-essay competition is open to all students in grades 9-12, with the top prize being a \$30,000 scholarship award. Nearly 40,000



high school students complete in the annual competition.

The Patriot's Pen essay competition is open to all students in grades 6-8, and the 2018-19 competition asks students to examine the statement, *"Why I Honor the American Flag."* The first-place winner will receive a \$5,000 award.
