TOURNAMENT RULES

1. **ALL PARTICIPANTS MUST HAVE A CURRENT USBC YOUTH MEMBERSHIP (2018-19).**
2. Tournament events are Team, Singles and Doubles with 3 average Divisions. Events will be 3 games each.
3. **TOURNAMENT DIVISIONS:** Divisions are determined by average.
4. Participants must enter both singles and doubles events to bowl in either. Doubles will be bowled first. Team and doubles may be mixed or all boys or girls. An entrant may participate in the team event two (2) times, however, not more than two (2) players on one team can repeat on another team. The first team score bowled will count for All-events. Entrant may participate in singles/doubles event only once.
5. **AVERAGES:**
 - a. Participants will use their highest 2017-18 league average, (winter or summer) minimum of 12 games.
 - b. If no 2017-18 book average, bowlers will use highest average as of February 2, 2019 minimum 12 games or more.
 - c. If none of the above the bowler will be assigned an average of 220.
 - d. Bowlers are responsible for verifying his/her own average, whether submitted by the bowler, team captain or coach. Failure to use the proper average will result in disqualification, if the submitted average is lower than the actual average, scholarships shall be based on the submitted average if it is higher than the correct average. Corrections may be permitted up to the completion of the first game of a series.
 - e. Bowlers with a Sport/Challenge average, will have their average adjusted,
 - f. USBC Rule 319 (a) is applicable for this tournament. If at the time of bowling, the current season average, minimum of 12 games, is 10 pins or more higher than the 2017-18 average, the current average must be used,
A coach must verify all current averages with current standing sheet attached to entry before the participant bowls their first event.
6. **HANDICAP:** Shall be based on 90% of the difference between the entrant's average and 220.
7. **SUBSTITUTES:** Shall report at least 30 minutes prior to the scheduled time to bowl with a properly completed substitute form. The substitute will replace the designated bowler in the same line-up position. Once a substitution is made in any event the original bowler may not bowl in the event. Each team is responsible for obtaining their own substitutes.
8. **SCHEDULING:** Will be performed on a first received, first scheduled basis.
9. **CHECK-IN:** Bowler may check-in on an individual basis. Check-in is 1 hour prior to squad time. Anyone not checking in at least 10 minutes prior to the squad time may be replaced (if a replacement is available). If a team is short one prepaid bowler, an absentee score of 10 pins under the average of the absentee bowler may be used. (One absentee score per team)
10. Tardy bowlers who have not been replaced will begin play for score beginning with the frame being bowled. Bowlers not present when it is their turn to bowl will be credited with zero for that frame at the tournament director's discretion.
11. **AWARDS/SCHOLARSHIPS:** Awards will be based on the number of entries per division, at least one place for every six (6) entries. Division 1, 2 and 3 will be handicapped (no scratch awards). Bowler's awards will be a scholarship and appropriate medal. **OPTIONAL ALL- EVENTS-**To be eligible for All-Events Awards, the entrant must have paid the Optional All-Events fee. All-events awards will be scholarships and will be based on the number of entries per division, at least one place for every ten (10) entries. Scholarship funds will be through SMART. All prize fees will be returned 100%.
12. **APPEALS OR PROTESTS:** Must be confirmed in writing to Tournament Director no later than 72 hours after which the decision of the Tournament Director will be final. Appeals or protests will be handled in accordance with USBC rules.
13. **GENERAL:** Food and/or drink will not be permitted in the bowling area. Tournament entrants will not be permitted to smoke, chew tobacco or consume alcoholic beverages while participating in the tournament.
14. **DRESS CODE:** The USBC National Tournaments (Open and Women and Youth) dress code will apply. Entrants are expected to wear suitable and representative of participation in a championship event. USBC Youth Jersey's and other similar bowling related jerseys or league shirts are permitted. Participants are request to wear a shirt with a polo, sash or butterfly collar and casual slacks, jeans that are neat and in good condition are permitted. Collarless bowling jerseys will be permitted. Girls may wear capri-pants skorts, provided the length is beyond the fingertips when their arms extended down their sides. Boys and girls may wear shorts (No basketball type shorts) provided the length is beyond the fingertips when arms are extended down their sides. Cotton t-shirts, tank tops,hats, halter tops, bare midriiffs, spaghetti strap tops, sweat pants and spandex are not permitted. No electronic devices are permitted in the bowling area.
15. The Metro Phoenix USBC and USBC Youth will not be responsible for accidents or injuries that occur while traveling to or from the tournament site or during the tournament.
16. Only bowlers and tournament volunteers wearing USBC RVP credentials will be allowed in the bowler's area.
17. **TOURNAMENT OF CHAMPIONS:** Will be selected per State Youth rules. Metro Phoenix Youth Committee will determine the bowlers selected. If your team is chosen to go, you must represent the Metro Phoenix Youth.
18. Any rule not covered by the Association By-Laws or the Tournament Rules will be covered by USBC Tournament Rules and Regulations. Metro Phoenix Board decision is final.
19. This will be a **Junior Gold Qualifying event.** The bowlers doubles/singles scores (scratch) will be used. Entry fee is \$40.00 per entry and you must be a Junior Gold Card holder for the 2018-19 bowling season. Memberships for Junior Gold will be sold at the tournament site. \$10.00 for under 12 (birthday 8/1/06 or later) U12 Division, \$30.00 for U15/U20 (birthday 8/1/98-7/31/06.. Advancement will be at a ratio of 1:5 and major fraction thereof. If we have 8 entrants, the tournament will advance the winner under their 1:5 ratio. The second place finisher would be given the opportunity to pay any remaining balance between the entry monies collected and the entry fee of \$200.00.
