The Dorothy M. Rowe Scholarship was established by the Phoenix Women's Bowling Association upon dissolution of the association to create the newly merged Metro Phoenix USBC Association. Dorothy M Rowe approved the scholarship being established in her name as recognition of her long time service to the sport of bowling and her long time service to her country. Ms. Rowe served on the local Phoenix Women's Bowling Association Board of Directors, the state Arizona Women's Bowling Association Board of Directors and the national Women's International Bowling Association Board of Directors. She served several years as the local and state Association President. Ms. Rowe was inducted into the Hall of Fame of each organization in the category of meritorious service.

Dorothy M. Rowe was born in 1925 in Harrison Township, Pennsylvania. She attended and graduated high school in Columbus, Ohio. In 1943 after graduating high school, Ms. Rowe began a career in civil service for the Army and Air Corps at the Columbus Quartermaster Reserve Depot. She continued her civilian career with the Air Force at Luke AFB in 1953. She held various financial positions with the Comptroller Squadron culminating her career as Chief of Financial Analysis in October of 2013. Dorothy had a distinguished 70 year career of federal service having served under 13 presidents and 40 commanding officers. Her entire adult life was given to the service of her country and the men and women of the 56th Fighter Wing Comptroller Squadron were her family. Dorothy M. Rowe passed away on Saturday, March 15, 2014.

The Dorothy M. Rowe Scholarship's purpose is to provide scholarships to students that exemplify those characteristics of service that Dorothy Rowe showed throughout her life.

Eligibility Requirements

1. Applicant must be at least 17 years of age as of August 1 for the year applying for the scholarship and must not exceed the age of 20 years of age as of August 1 for the year applying for the scholarship.
2. Less than 30 college credit hours as of August 1 for the year applying for the scholarship.
3. Applicant must be a certified USBC bowler or sponsored by a current or past member (within the last 15 years) of the Greater Phoenix Bowling Association, Phoenix Women's Bowling Association, or the Metro Phoenix USBC Association and related to the applicant as a parent, grandparent, aunt, or uncle.
4. Applicant must have attended a High School within the Metro Phoenix USBC Association Geographical Boundaries.
5. Applicant must attend an accredited college, university, or vocational school.
6. Applications must be received by June 30 of the year applying.
