WHO:	The tournament is open to all bowlers who are current members of USBC as of January 11, 2026.

WHEN:	<b>Check-in</b> Qualifying: Finals:	Sunday January 11, 2026 8:00am Sunday January 11, 2026 @ 9:00 AM (ONE SQUAD ONLY) Immediately following
FORMAT:	This is a SCRATCH event. All participants will bowl 6 games of qualifying, moving to a different pair of lanes after each game. Upon conclusion of qualifying, the field will be cut to the top 8 (based on less than 48 entries), and top 12 based on 48 entries or more. The 2024 champion will be part of the bracket and seeded based on their qualifying position (if outside of the cut line, will be the final seed in the bracket).  Top 8 bracket: 1 vs 8, 2 vs 7, etc. for the first round. Every round will be 2 games, total pin fall matches.  Top 12 bracket: Seeds 1-4 will receive a 1 round bye, and the first round will consist of seeds 5-12 (5 vs 12, 6 vs 11 etc). Every round will be 2 games, total pin fall matches.  Tournament Manager reserves the right to adjust the format based on number of entries.	
ENTRY FEE:	The Master's entry fee is \$120.00 (Lineage and Expenses \$40.00, Prize Fund \$80.00). The Queen's entry fee is \$100.00 (Lineage and Expenses \$40.00, Prize Fund \$60.00). Excess lineage and expense money, if any, will be added to the prize fund.	
PRIZE FUND:	The prize fund will be returned 100%. Additional places will be paid on a minimum of 1:5 ratio. Prize money will be awarded immediately following completion of the tournament, unless contested. The Champion's award will be purchased from the tournament expense fund and in addition, the 2026 Master/Queen will receive a paid spot into the Arizona State Masters/Queens Tournament and 2026 USBC Masters/Queens National Tournament.	
GENERAL:	One-lane courtesy will be observed. Entries will be accepted up to qualifying squad time. USBC Tournament Rules and Regulations shall govern items not covered by these rules. Bowling balls not released to the public will not be allowed.	
BRACKETS:	Optional bracket and side pots may be available	
ORESS CODE:	Proper bowling attire: Allowed - Polo Shirt, Bowling Jersey, Collared Shirt, Hemmed Jean Shorts, Jeans (neat & clean), Dress or Casual Pants, Capri Pants, Skirt, Skort (length below fingertips). NOT ALLOWED: T-Shirts, Tank tops, Collegiat Skorts, Workout attire (sweatpants, sweatshirts, spandex), Leggings/Jeggings of any kind, Halter tops, Bare midriff/tube tops, Sleeveless tops, and Spaghetti tops, Hats or Headwear, Caps, Clothing with obscenities, Holes, Frays, Tears. The Tournament Director will have the final decision regarding acceptable attire.
