The percentage of people in the world who have access to an improved water source has **increased by 15%** since 1990, but the battle is far from over.

At least **1.8 BILLION** people worldwide are drinking water that is fecally contaminated.

More than **3 MILLION** people die annually from the consequences of water-related diseases.

The vast majority of these deaths are children under **5 YEARS OLD.**

The average ice sheet takes **90 GALLONS** to resurface. If this rink is resurfaced only 4 times each day, around **130,000 GALLONS** will be used in **ONE YEAR**. (Most rinks resurface their ice more than 8 times per day.)
