

Finance Report

2021 revenue:	\$147,979
2021 expenses:	\$127,920 (Not including dredging)

The Board has hired an attorney to represent Maple Lake in collecting outstanding dues and fees. Our attorney is actively working through the debts and the Club expects to have a new settlement shortly. As of February 2022, there are currently \$81,273.45 total in arrears.

Long Term Planning Committee Update

The Long Term Planning Committee was formed near the end of 2021 to help set a more clear direction of Lake operations for the current and future Board of Directors. The stated purpose of the LTP Committee is to preserve the health of Maple Lake and detail the maintenance of the lake, dam, roads, clubhouse, and infrastructure in order to protect and enhance Maple Lake for the enjoyment of present and future generations. By-laws Committee Update

The committee has been meeting regularly and is nearly ready with proposed updates to the Club's By-laws. Language has been cleaned up and clarified, past motions from Annual Meetings have been incorporated, and flexibility around the data and time of the Annual Meeting have been proposed. Details will be included with the Annual Meeting packets next month.

Dredging Update

Dredging of the lake is at 75% completion based on the allocated funding. The dredging company is currently waiting for the weather to cooperate so that they can continue operations.
