RESOLUTION NO. 03-23

SUBJECT: Increase of Tribal Employment Rights Ordinance Fees.

WHEREAS: The Big Pine Paiute Tribal Council is the duly-elected governing body of the Big Pine Paiute Tribe of the Owens Valley, which is a federally-recognized Tribe; and

WHEREAS: The Tribal Employment Rights Ordinance (TERO) of the Big Pine Paiute Tribe of the Owens Valley has previously been adopted and enacted since September of 1990; and

WHEREAS: The Big Pine Tribal Council wishes to increase the previously set TERO fee from the current rate of 2% to 3% on any projects the Big Pine Paiute Tribe may become involved in.

THEREFORE BE IT NOW RESOLVED: That the Big Pine Tribal Council has reviewed and approved the increase of the TERO fees from 2% to 3%, thus negating all other fee rates previously enacted by the Big Pine Paiute Tribe of the Owens Valley.


CERTIFICATION
