



2026 Cliff Hyink Wood Scholarship Application

Description: Scholarships for Students enrolled in T.O.H.S. Wood Classes

This scholarship is available for **Thousand Oaks High School** graduating students in the Wood Classes who will enroll in a 2 or 4-year college/university or vocational school immediately after high school graduation. Two \$1000 one-year scholarships are available. Students enrolled in the Wood Program at TOHS are highly encouraged to apply for this scholarship.

Use of Scholarship: The scholarships are to be used for tuition, books, and miscellaneous expenses of the recipients to further their academic or career education.

Application: Applications are available at the Kiwanis Club of Thousand Oaks website at www.tokiwanis.org or contact your Wood Shop Instructor. Application must be **received** no later than **5 PM, April 1, 2026**.

Guidelines: Must have a GPA of 2.5 or higher. **Please attach GPA confirmation.** Financial need will also be considered, please include that information in your essay.

Student Application Packet - 4 things:

1. **Application Information form:** This should include your name and the college/university you plan to attend if known. If a selection has not been made, please tell us to what schools you have applied.
2. **Essay Required:** What intrigues you about working with wood? How do you see that furthering your education will impact your life. What are your goals?
3. **Letter of Recommendation:** Please ask your instructor or mentor to include a letter of recommendation. See letter form and follow instructions.
4. **GPA** confirmation of 2.5 or higher-attach confirmation

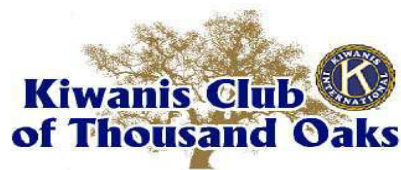
Selection:
