

2025 Kelli & Austin Sincock Scholarship for the Arts Application

General Information

The Award

The Kelli & Austin Sincock Scholarship for the Arts is offered through the Kiwanis Club of Thousand Oaks. Four (4) scholarships of \$1,000 each will be awarded to four (4) graduating students from Thousand Oaks, Newbury Park, Westlake, Oak Park, Agoura or Century Academy High Schools who intend to pursue a field of study in the Arts (performing arts, studio arts, visual arts) in the fall of 2025.

Use of Scholarship

The scholarships are to be used for the recipient's tuition, books, and miscellaneous expenses to further their academic or career education in the Arts.

Application

Application form is included here in this packet and is also available at the Kiwanis Club of Thousand Oaks Website at **www.tokiwanis.org**. A completed application and supporting documents must be received via email or ground mail no later than 5 PM on Tuesday, April 1st, 2025.

- 1. This scholarship is open to:
- a. Students who wish to attend a trade, technical, or specialized school in the Arts.
- b. Students who wish to pursue a Baccalaureate degree in the Arts.
- c. Students who wish to pursue an Associate Degree in the Arts.
- 2. The student must have demonstrated a commitment to pursuing a career in the Arts.

Eligibility

Graduating high school students having a minimum 3.0 GPA.

Selection

The final decision of awards will be made by the Kiwanis Club of Thousand Oaks Kelli & Austin Sincock Scholarship for the Arts Committee. Selection will be made primarily on the basis of commitment to the Arts, answers to application questions, personal essay and letter(s) of recommendation. Financial need will also be considered, if appropriate.



Presentation of Award

Recipients will be notified by email. They will be honored and presented their award (by check made out to the student) at a regular meeting of the Kiwanis Club of Thousand Oaks in May, 2025. Recipients will also be recognized at their school's awards night.
