

General Information

Two (2) Kiwanis Club of Thousand Oaks Key Club Member Scholarship awards will be given to two (2) graduating students from Thousand Oaks, Newbury Park, Westlake, Oak Park, Agoura or Century Academy High Schools who intend to enroll in a two or four year college, university or technical school in the fall of 2025. The scholarship is open to students who have been active in their school's Key Club. Each awardee will receive a one-year scholarship of \$1,000.

Use of Scholarship

The scholarships are to be used for the recipient's tuition, books, and miscellaneous expenses to further their academic or career education in the fall of 2025.

Application

An application form is included here in this packet and is also available at the Kiwanis Club of Thousand Oaks website at www.tokiwanis.org. The completed and signed application and su pporting documentsmust be received via email or ground mail no later than 5 PM on Tuesday, April 1, 2025.

- 1. This scholarship is open to:
 - a. Students who wish to pursue a Baccalaureate degree.
 - b. Students who wish to pursue an Associate Degree.
 - c. Students who wish to attend a trade, technical, or specialized school.
- 2. The student, in the personal essay, must show a commitment to pursuing future studies in higher education and intend to graduate with a degree.

Eligibility

Graduating high school students having a minimum 3.0 GPA who have been and currently are active in their high school's Key Club program.



Selection

The final decision of awards will be made by the Kiwanis Club of Thousand Oaks Scholarship Committee. Selection will be made primarily on the basis of Key Club activity, information on the application form, personal essay and letter(s) of recommendation.:Note: Importance will be given to a student's volunteering or community service activities. Financial need will also be considered, if appropriate.

Presentation of Award:

Recipients will be notified by email. They will be honored and presented their award (a check made out to the student) at a regular meeting of the Kiwanis Club of Thousand Oaks in May, 2025. Recipients will also be recognized at their high school's award night.
