1. *Easy*. In places that you care about, ask...

What do you think about this place Lord? How can I pray? I thank and praise you for _____.

What do you want to do here to bring more beauty and your goodness?

Where is there sin and results of sin that break your heart? Break my heart too. I am angry about _____, and in the name of Jesus' this is not welcome here.

2. *Easier*. Pray Scripture

Some verses from the Bible that are declarative prayers and blessing prayers are on the back page.

3. *Easiest*. Listen & Pray Worship Music

Agree with lyrics of worship music as you walk. Take a prayer drive and worship along in your car! You can sing walking if you feel comfortable or just whisper, repeating some of the words. Invite the Holy Spirit to let the things that delight God, bring you delight. See inside the front cover for playlists.

Preparation

Take some time to read through the full armor of God from Ephesians 6. Asking God to protect you.

What does the Lord bring to your mind as you begin to think about our community? Before you pray for others, pray for yourself.

There may be hard memories with places or broken relationships with people here, ask the Gentle Shepherd to guide you in how to be healed from those hurts. Give those broken things to God to bring to justice, and restore.

Invitation

Prayer walking is a type of intercessory prayer that involves walking in a particular place while praying. As we prayer walk, our prayers extend beyond your own concerns, focusing directly on the needs of others and opening yourself to see them with God's eyes and heart.

Prayer walks are a means of asking God to give us a heart for your neighborhood, city, and land. It gives us a concrete means of doing something for the well-being of our town as we ask the Holy Spirit to pray through us as we observe the world around you.

Before heading out for a prayer-walk ask God to give insight into what other's needs might be. Your heart will be moved to pray for the things you see during the walk.

For example, you might come across a place that is extremely untidy and rundown. This might prompt you to pray for the health, both physical and spiritual, of the people there.

Or, as you walk past a home you could ask God to bring the people who live there to know and love Him. Ask that their children and their descendants will all become believers.

You'll think of many other things to pray for as you go!
