Our Promise



All staff and volunteers have a DBS check to make sure they are safe to work with adults at risk.



All staff and volunteers have training on safeguarding



We will listen carefully if someone tells us something is wrong



We will take action quickly if anyone is at risk



We will treat everyone with respect and kindness



We will work with Dorset Council and others to keep everyone safe



We will support people to make their own safe choices

Talk to Angie or Vicky (DSLs)



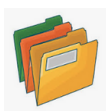
