Morphological features

- Canopy : Semi-compact
- Stem : Red-purple with green pigment highly scattered throughout
- Leaflet : Ovate-lanceolate
- Flower : Blue-violet
- Tuber : Pink, ovoid with medium-deep eyes and cream flesh
- Sprout : Pink



Agronomic features

- Adaptability : North-Bengal hills and Sikkim
- Maturity : Medium
- Average yield potential : 250-300 q/ha
- Storability : Good
- Reaction to diseases/pests : Early blight – not tested
: Late blight – moderately resistant
: Charcoal rot – not tested
: Wart – immune
: Viruses – not tested
: Cyst nematodes – susceptible
- Consumer and processing quality : Easy to cook, texture waxy, flavour mild, free from after-cooking discoloration.
- Special attributes : Slow rate of degeneration
