We had an Operating Loss of about \$8,200 for the month as Total Income was \$7,400 under budget and Total Expenses were \$800 over budget. Total Contributions were just at a low point. Our expenses, for the most part, were pretty much in line except that we paid a large bill for maintenance as air conditioners were serviced. Our Cash in Bank remains at an acceptable level at month-end if we can just boost our October contributions.

We also are working with the city of Windsor Heights to complete some sidewalk repairs that were mandated by them.
