



Connection, Civility and Care



The **September Operating Statement** shows us that we must keep our noses to the grindstone to continue to show successful results. Our expenses, for the most part, were pretty much in line except that we paid a large bill for maintenance as air conditioners were serviced. Our Cash in Bank remains at an acceptable level at month-end if we can just boost our October contributions.
