Practicing the Way Spiritual Practices —Scripture 101

Windsor on Wednesdays kicks off January 14th at 5:45 with a mini-series on the Spiritual Practice of Scripture. This is a follow-up from the *Practicing the Way* course from this fall. We'll go deeper, learning how engaging with God's word can help us connect with God and change how we live. We'll do some exercises and readings, watch videos and discuss to deepen our understanding of the foundation of our faith. Worship Rotation

This fall we began experimenting with a rotation of worship and music styles. This is something the worship team has been working toward for a couple of years. As we worship our way into the new year, we'll strive to offer intentional and creative worship experiences with excellent and diverse music. Because we connect to God in various ways, we are offering a variety of worship styles. **Community Worship** blends modern hymns and contemporary with organ and piano. **Traditional Worship**, featuring the organ, employs traditional hymns, liturgies, and creeds. **Worship with the Band** is a plugged in and playful mix of contemporary music that features guitar, bass, drums, piano and vocals. **Acoustic Worship** involves piano only, or piano and strings (violin and cello).

We would love your feedback as we try out these and other worship styles. We hope you will engage all of these experiences so that you may be moved into deeper relationship with God and one another, because when we gather to hear God's word and sing praises, God is with us, transforming us and the world we are sent to serve.

The **November Operating** statement indicates that our congregation has the wherewithal to show resiliency when it is needed. We went from a loss month to a profitable one just when we needed to do it. Our Net Operating Income for November was \$4,500 as Total Income was \$2,900 over budget and Total Expenses were \$1,600 under budget. We received two large gifts that totaled \$9,125 that gave us a big boost. General Contributions were \$4,600 in excess of budget while all expense categories were under budget. December is also showing that it will be a good month for us we have already received two large gifts totaling \$9,000. The spirit is alive and well at Windsor in this Christmas season.
