Yes...... we have parking in the front hayfield with an entrance just after the farm driveway at 476 Pearsonville Road. Please use that entrance and not the main driveway.

When you arrive, don't rush to saddle up. Come up to the main barn tack room to get your saddle pad name, check in and receive your wristband and sign a waiver. If you have printed a waiver off the website and signed it in advance, please just drop it off.

We will meet for a short intro on horseback promptly at 1 pm to give you an overview of the plan for your workshop.

Protective headgear is mandatory for juniors and optional for adults; but encouraged.

If you are a seasoned pro or a newbie....it doesnt matter.....

Cost of Each workshop is \$60 (includes HST)

Yes we have a mounting block in the field just outside the ring.

As this is a workshop, I do not have any food scheduled or items to purchase here. If you would like snacks, or food, please bring along your own items.
